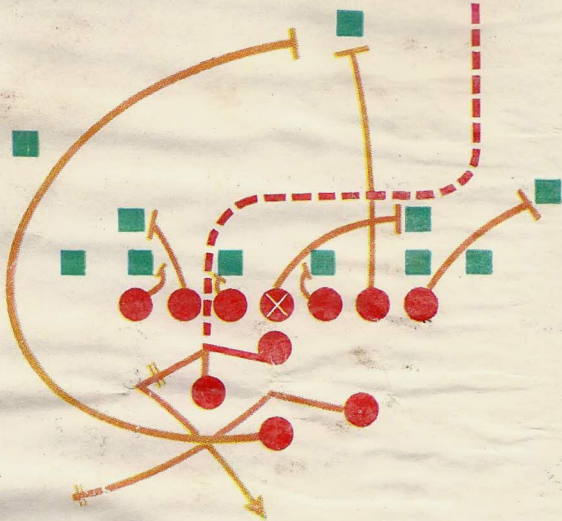

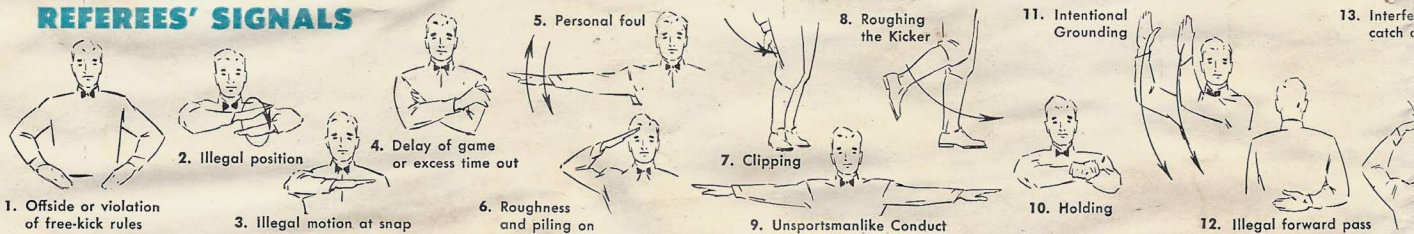

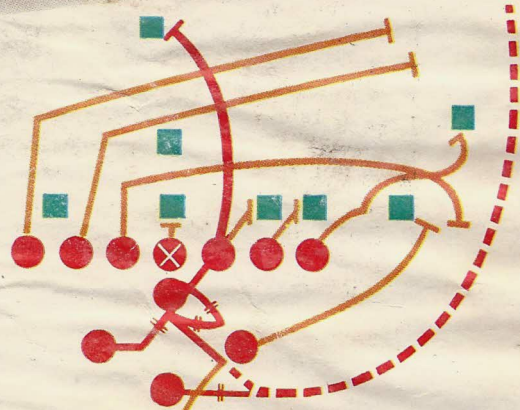

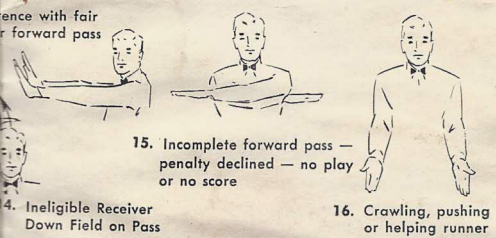

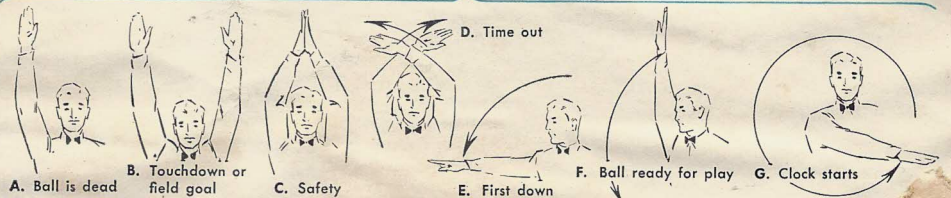
Lateral fake trap, against an overshifted six-man line.
