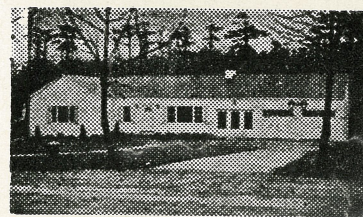

PERRY SCOTT
Head Coach

L. Perry Scott - Head Coach of Football and Assistant Coach of Track - graduated from Bernardsville High School, New Jersey, in 1937, received a P.H.B. degree at Muhlenberg College in 1941, and M.A. from Lehigh University in 1954. During World War II he served as a Captain in the Air Force, and survived many bombing missions over Germany. He played professional football with the Detroit Lions and the Bethlehem Bulldogs. His coaching career was started by serving as line coach to J. Birney Crum, and succeeding him as head coach. He begins his eighth season with an exceptional record among the scholastic coaches of the country. Record to date: 1950 season - won 8, lost 2; 1951 season - won 8, lost 1, tied 1; 1952 season - won 10, lost 1; 1953 season - won 8, tied 2; 1954 season - won 8, lost 2; 1955 season - won 3, lost 7; 1956 season - won 9, lost 2.

Welcome . . . Neshaminy H. S.

Allentown High welcomes a new and powerful opponent on its schedule, the Neshaminy Redskins. Under the tutelage of Coach Harry Frank, for the past five years the Redskins have cut a wide swath in the Lower Bucks County League. His teams have won the championship 4 times and tied it once. Harry has compiled an enviable record of 44 wins, 5 losses, and 1 tie. He is a strong advocate of the single wing offense but has added the multiple offense to his attack.

Frank Conroy, an All-League tackle, is the keystone of the forward wall. Frank has a fine running backfield featuring speedster Tom Stricher, who has 3 or 4 touchdown runs of from 13 to 40 yards. Big Jerry Mladjen, a rough house fullback is a full fledged veteran and was all-county last year. Neshaminy had a 9-0-1 mark last year.
