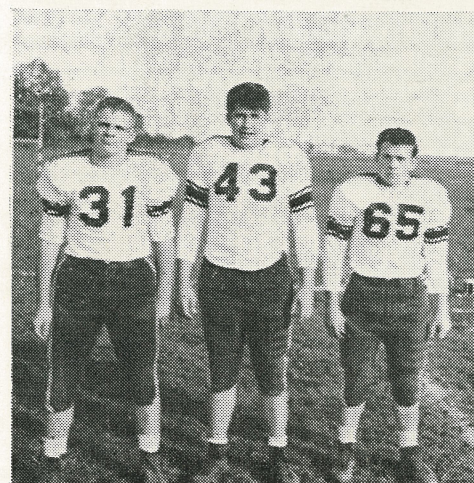

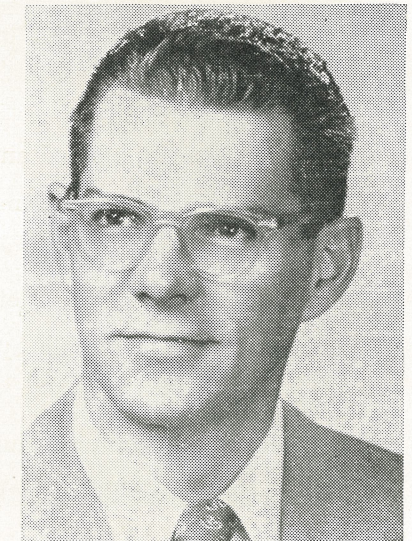
**Junior High School Football Coach — George Lindsay**

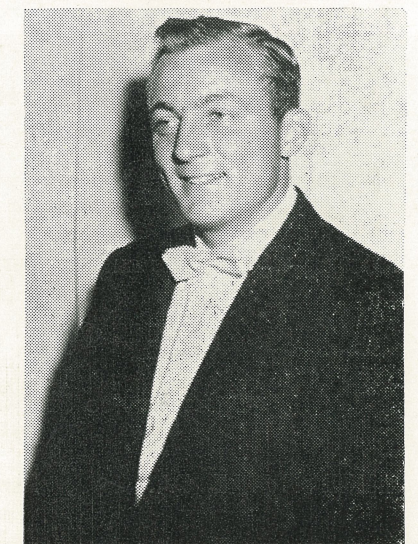
Mr. Speakman teaches math and science in the Junior High grades and is sponsor of the rifle club.

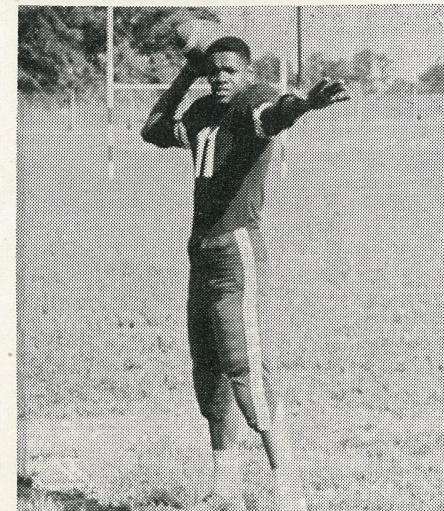
