the determined REDSKINS take the field against the first of three non-league battles. Needless to say, this is the BIG ONE. Next to winning their eighth straight league championship, the coaches and players alike want this game.

Tonight marks the final of a four game series with Pennridge dating back to 1956. In the first contest the RED-SKINS blanked the Rams 20-0, only to lose 13-0 in 1957 and again last year 26-13.

Pennridge brings to the Neshaminy Stadium an experienced line including 8 letter winners from last year's second place Bucks-Montgomery League eleven. How well the REDSKIN front wall can dent the (180 average) Ram line will spell the difference tonight.

Tonight's first outing for the Rams will give their coaches the answers to many questions about their inexperienced backfield, which is without the services of last year's first two sets of backs.


The REDSKINS looked good and bad in their first outing beating Bristol 46-7. Last week's win was typical of the traditional Neshaminy Lightning as the much improved running of Jack Stricker and wiry Franny McCollum hit the holes quickly for impressive gains. But 1959 will become more known for its thunder with the big man, Harry Schuh, more destructive than ever, and workhorse Tom Rickards doing his share of damage. Sophomores Kaminski and Held also showed plenty of power.

The win over Bristol indicated that the "menup front" could not only open up the holes for the ball carriers, but also halt the opponent's intent to advance the pigskin.

Tonight's front wall of Frentrop, Evans, Rhoads, White, Cummings, Watkins and Fiorelli will have a job cutting up a good Ram line, while the defensive "savages" of Rickards, Bockhorn, Sylvester, Held, Schuh and company will have to give a repeat performance of last week's second half if the seniors on the squad can add Pennridge to their three-year list of victories.
