

the NESHAMINY REDSKINS dig in for their third battle of the season with their opponents the ever-dangerous Panthers of William Tennent High School.

The REDSKINS will be going with the same lineup including ends Ed Fiorelli and Werner Frentrop, guards Satch Watkins and Tom Evans, tackles Ed Rhoads, and Barry White, center Herb Cummings and in the backfield John Kurtz, Harry Schuh, Jack Stricker and Tom Rickards.

In addition to the starting offensive eleven the Skins have been getting plenty of help from Don Bockhorn, Jerry Lauther, Tony Sylvester, Fred Ermel, and Bob Rumsey, seniors; Jack Currie and Franny McCollum, juniors; and an outstanding array of sophomore talent in backs Kaminski and Held, ends Kalan and Rell, and tackles Bonsal and Carber. Bonsal also kicks off for the Skins.

The REDSKINS have looked good but they cannot look forward to the big game with Easton before they take care of the Panthers tonight and Council Rock next week.

Neshaminy students and fans alike are getting the championship fever, but that is still a long way off, let's hope it gets a little closer after tonight's game. We'll all find out.....





Both boys are seniors of this year's squad. Ed and Werner are double-duty ends--playing both offensive and defensive football.




Savages-


