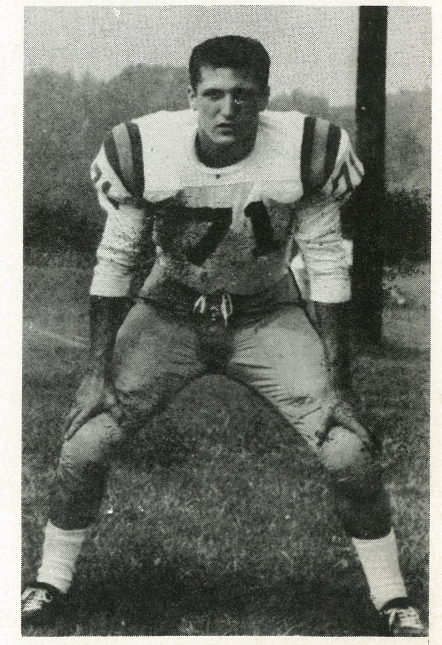
WELL, YELL YOU REDSKINS, YELL!

As The Whistle Blows Jack Stricker

The BULLDOGS of Morrisville High School once again challenge the NESHAMINY REDSKINS for the Lower Bucks League crown. This is nothing new to area sport fans and once again all eyes are centered on what could be the final game between these two elevens for some time--in 1961 the Lower Bucks League is scheduled to divide into two divisions.

For the REDSKINS, this game marks the mid-point of the 1960 season and as yet no team--including the State's powerful Easton Red Rovers--has been able to set back the rampaging Skins. NESHAMINY has given every member of its 33-man squad ample opportunity to mix it up in scoring 172 points for a five-game average of 34, while holding its five opponents to but four TD's or a five-point defensive average.

The Bulldogs, however, have not as yet been seriously challenged in their first three wins over seemingly weak opponents. Morrisville scored easy wins over Egan, Pennsbury and Council Rock. Tonight the Bulldogs will meet their first real test of the season.

See the next two pages as these two exciting athletes are shown side by side with each one's outstanding athletic accomplishments. This league has known many fine athletes----but never before have sport fans compared athletes such as Hart and Schuh.

As always, the Bulldogs bring in to this game a rugged forward wall led by 235-pound tackle Straszynski and a solid backfield full of up-the-middle power (Hart), around-the-ends speed (Giano and Cominski), pitchouts to (Hart and Cominski), and passing by T-quarterback (Zawatsky) to his ends and backfield companions.

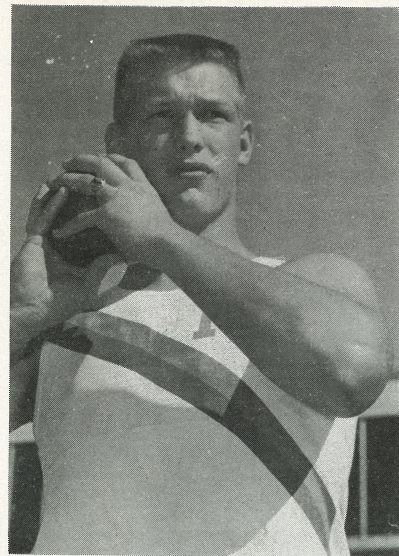
Morrisville's team will not change too much when the ball changes hands but in addition to the offensive lineup shown on the inside pages, look for Hart to play defensive tackle, Cutchineal, Cappiello, Clark and Petryszak to lend a hand in an attempt to stop the REDSKIN machine.

The SKINS are rolling again in 1960. The supposedly question mark-line has quickly ripened into NESHAMINY's heaviest and most destructive offensive machine. At the present rate of 34 points per game, the SKINS could set a new scoring record. The backs are blocking and running better than any of the previous eight championship units of old and sport fans tonight can once again take in two of PENNSYLVANIA'S finest backs in three-year veterans Jack Stricker and Harry Schuh.

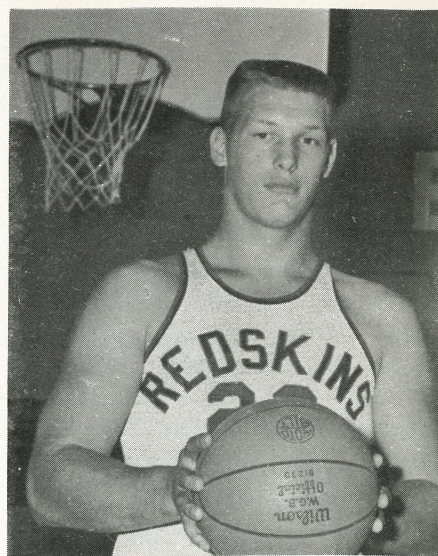
The REDSKINS, who have held down the scores in the last two games by benching the first unit, should have only little difficulty in maintaining its offensive game average. The problem will be put squarely on the shoulders of the Jack Curie-led defensive unit to stop the threat of Hart-Cominski and company. The defensive unit of Schuh, Garber, Carroll, Bonsall, Currie, Rell, Buhner, Boerckel, Stricker, and McCollum... need only put on a repeat performance of the Easton game.

The SKINS are back home. NESHAMINY fans will be looking for the SKINS to "whoop it up!" Will they? We'll all find out...

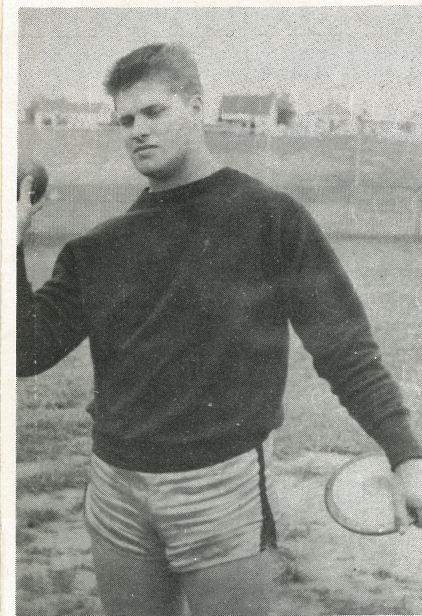
