





### Player of the Week


BOB BAXTER (NESHAMINY'S LUCKY CHARM)

There is no question as to who merits the title of Player of the Week or should we say "Weeks." The Big Number 50 has scored Neshaminy's last five touchdowns. Bob scored both TD's in the Easton game with a run of 51 yards and a 25 yard pass from Brundzo. Baxter began where he left off — scoring all three TD's against the Canaries of Allentown with runs of 78,61 and 32 yards plus kicking all three conversions.

He has now compiled 42 of Neshaminy's total of 56 points thus far this season. This brings Bob's three year scoring total to 308 points, lacking 29 points to break the L.B.C. Career Scoring Record of 337 points held by former Redskin Great Harry Schuh. Bob scored 75 points as a sophomore and a record 191 in his junior year.

All eyes seem to be glued on the impressive fullback who never ceases to amaze the fans. Neshaminy is proud and honored to have the opportunity to highlight this great athlete.

### Halfway to Another Undefeated Season

#### REVIEWING THE GAME . . . . .

Those who have been following Redskin football have undoubtedly come to the conclusion that even though Neshaminy may not be playing the best football they are certainly playing the most exciting. Victory has not come easily for the "Skins" who have won 2 games by one touchdown, 2 by one point and have recorded one scoreless tie.

Neshaminy owns proud possession of first place in the East Penn Football League having beat Easton 14-9 and William Allen 21-20. This year marks the first time that thirteen points has not been seen on the scoreboard of a Neshaminy-Easton contest. Although Baxter was the big name of the night, scoring both touchdowns, the story might have been different if Guard John Troyano had not recovered a Neshaminy fumble in the end zone to give Easton a 2 point safety instead of a tying TD.

Last Friday night the "Skins" rolled up their third "come from behind" victory, edging the under-rated Canaries of Allentown 21-20. The great showing of Bob Baxter, scoring all of the Neshaminy points, proved to be too much for Allen who was vying for its first season victory.

These two victories boosted Neshaminy's winning string to 25. The Redskins have not been defeated since they were set back 13-7 by Easton in 1961. In fact the Redskins have lost only two games in their last 57 contests, dating back to the 13-7 defeat at the hands of Easton in 1959.

#### TONIGHT . . . . .

For the first time Neshaminy will host the Dieruff High Huskies from Allentown. Head Coach Ernest Wescoe's powerful "11" boasts a 3-1 record thus far this season, having defeated Pottstown, Lancaster and local Pennsbury. Their one loss was at the hands of the Easton Red Rovers 7-6. However, Dieruff out-played Easton throughout the entire game losing it when they fumbled on their own two yard line with one minute to play. If Neshaminy continues its typical season play, tonight's contest should prove to be another thriller when . . . . . .

#### SWIMMING

Swimming has become a major sport at Neshaminy. Last year the Redskin Mermen recorded a 10-1 log beating Philadelphia Public League Champ, Northeast High School, Abington, Trenton and District | PIAA Champs, Pennsbury.

The Redskins made an impressive showing in District Championships and sent a strong medley relay team to the State PIAA Championship at Bucknell University where they missed taking first place by two seconds.

The 1963-64 season looks good for Neshaminy. The team opens against LaSalle High on November 26 and continues to swim what is probably the most difficult high school schedule in Eastern Pennsylvania. The team will compete in the annual Christmas Tournament at Abington High School and has high hopes of repeating its trip to the State Championships in March,
