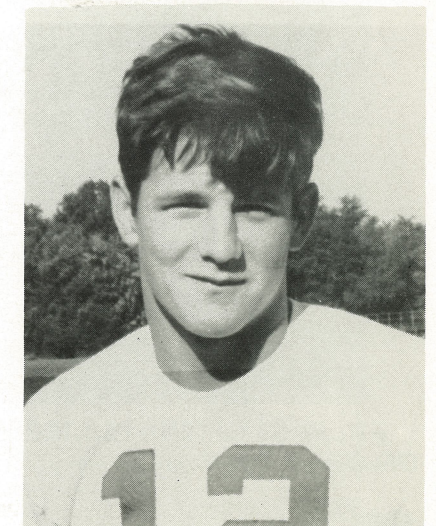
SOME CHANGES YOU SHOULD NOTICE !

The starting center for Egan last year was No. 50 - Chuck Lodge. The starting center for Neshaminy tonight is No. 50 - Chuck Lodge ! Same guy but a change of uniform as Chuck transferred to the Skins school last spring. Veteran center No. 43 - Bruce McHale was All-County and All-Big 7 among other awards but because of his speed and size will move to tight end to bolster the front line. His willingness to make the move shows why Bruce has the respect of fellow players and coaches - he is the team player ! Kick-return specialist and All-County defensive halfback No. 14 - Dal Forchetti starts at split - end where his speed and elusiveness should keep opposing defenses alert. Starting quarterback tonight will be No. 12 - Bob Grupp who steps into this role from the JV squad. This change was necessitated by a muscle injury to Pete Cordelli during the pre-season work-outs. These changes will all have an important part in this opening game for the Redskins tonight.
