Neshaminy humbled in Allentown

ALLENTOWN — The Neshaminy football team unveiled its latest version of the wishbone offense against Dieruff High School Friday night at Allentown's J. Birney Crum Stadium.

With one returning backfield starter — halfback Steve Derry — and junior Careem Hunte taking over the controls at quarterback, the Redskin attack fared well out of the locker room.

The problem was, every time the offense got the ball it trailed by another touchdown.

Dieruff drove for 65 yards and a score on the first possession of the game, pulled away to a 41-8 halftime lead and rolled 61-24, setting a school record for points scored in a game.

Fullback John Flamish rushed for 208 yards, 174 by intermission, and five touchdowns. Running mate Eric Freeman added 116 yards. All told, Dieruff gained 398 yards on the ground against a pourous Neshaminy defense.

"I think we're gonna see the film and we're not gonna be as

bad as we think we are right now," said head coach Dick Bedesem. "We missed an awful lot of tackles."

Dieruff's senior-dominated team went just 1-10 a year ago. However, Neshaminy's arm tackling made it look like the 1992 squad which went 10-1 to win the championship of the powerful East Penn Conference.

"They've got a nice team," Bedesem said. "They really took it to us. We have to come together more tackling-wise. We have to swarm more."

Dieruff opened conservatively with quick-hitting runs up the middle. It marched from its own 35 to the Redskin 39 before linebacker Jim Rogers finally stuffed one for the visitors.

No matter, Dieruff quarterback Juan Morales completed an 11-yard pass on third and 7. Three snaps later, Flamish scored his first from 17 yards out on an off-tackle play.

Neshaminy moved on its opening possession from its 26 to the Dieruff 46. Hunte rushed for 19 yards in the drive, but his incom-

plete pass on third and 10 forced a punt.

Then Flamish exploited the Redskin defense some more. He rushed three times for 91 yards and a quick touchdown. The scoring play was a handoff up the middle in which he broke through the line, ran over a defensive back and sprinted 80 yards for the end zone.

The play seemed to demoralize Neshaminy. It went like that the rest of the evening for the Redskins.

A two-play drive made it 20-0 just 29 seconds into the second quarter. A Neshaminy fumble set up a one-play 28-yard score. That made it three touchdowns on six offensive plays.

"For us to be successful, the offense will have to control the ball more and keep the defense off the field," Bedesem said.

"They were good," said Neshaminy halfback Tim Smith, who scored all three of his team's touchdowns. "The defense will just have to come out and play better next week."

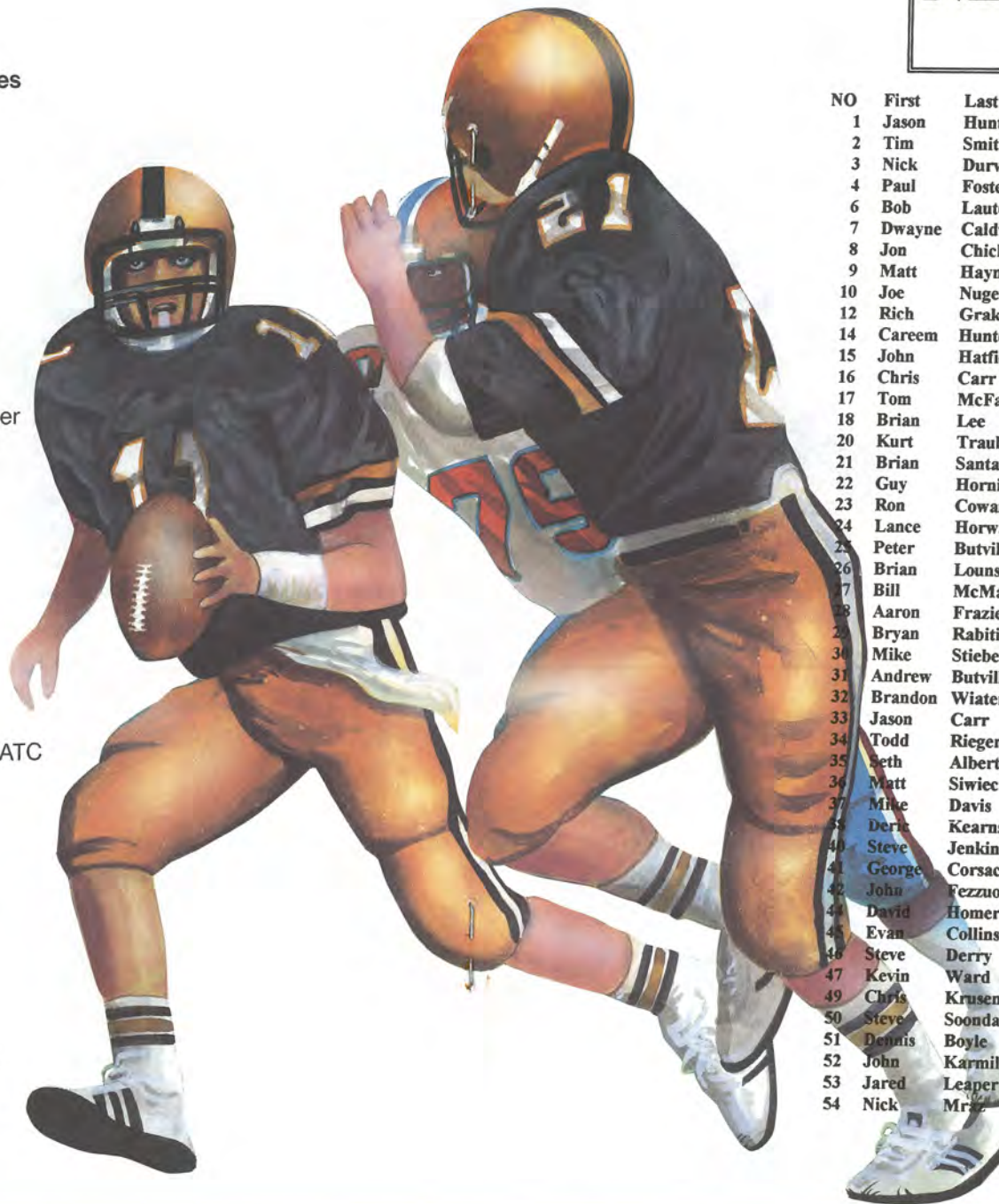
