Hall of Fame Game

Owls' second-half play decides issue

LANGHORNE — Two new head coaches in the tough Suburban One League Power Ten Conference squared off on the gridiron Friday on Heartbreak Ridge.

Dennis Strobel of Bensalem Township and Mark Schmidt of Neshaminy lost opening non-league games last week. However, both squads played well in defeat.

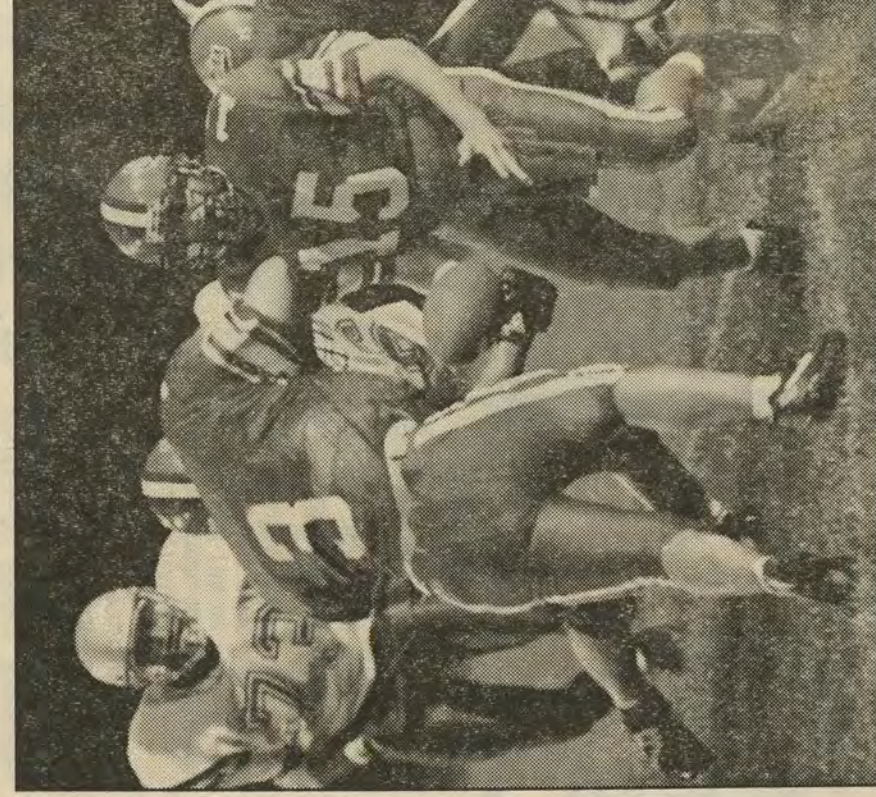
This time Neshaminy got the upper hand, but Bensalem came from behind to record a 21-13 victory.

The game started out in an all too familiar pattern as far as the Owls were concerned. Neshaminy took the opening kickoff and marched 81 yards in just five plays for the first score. Tim Smith raced 34 yards for the touchdown. Bob Miller's conversion put the Redskins up 7-0.

Bensalem coach Dennis Strobel is getting tired of watching the opposing team score early. "We continue to shoot ourselves in the foot," noted Strobel. "We have to come out fired up in the future. We can't afford to do that."

The Owls scored late in the first half when Anthony Nero hit Neshaminy quarterback John Hatfield, forcing a fumble. Bensalem then drove 48 yards for the tying score. Quarterback Ted Minnichbach connected on a 14 yard strike to Charles Maddocks for the equalizer. Frank Lombardo's extra point tied the score.

The first half was a game of inches, with the Owls coming up short twice. Lombardo tried a 32-yard field goal that hit the

crossbar. On the final play of the first half, Rob Dunner caught a short pass and reached for the goal line as he was being tackled, but came away inches shy of paydirt.

Bensalem did not get dismayed about those close calls. "We were kind of disappointed that we didn't score those

times," stated Strobel. "It showed that we could take the ball down field. Even though we didn't get in, we knew we could score. That helped us for the second half."

And what a second half it was for the Owls. They controlled the ball in the third quarter. Bensalem ate up most of the clock in the quarter with an 86-yard

drive. Minnichbach, who completed six of 18 passes for 72 yards, threw his second TD pass with a 10-yard strike to Mike Fleming on the 11th play of the drive.

Late in the third quarter, Minnichbach, a two-way performer, set up Bensalem's last score with an interception. On the first play of the last quarter, Joe Thompson scampered 20 yards up the middle to give the Owls a 21-7 lead.

He carried the ball 10 times for a total of 77 yards. Marcus Bradshaw picked up an additional 51 yards, while Minnichbach totaled the pigskin for 45 more. The Owls outtrushed the Redskins 195-97.

By no means did Neshaminy give up. David O'Brien replaced the injured John Hatfield at quarterback and got the Redskins back in the game with a 21-yard strike to speedster Car-eem Huntie.

The Redskins did manage to get the ball back for one last try, but the Bensalem defense, led by 6-1, 220-pounder lineman Darren Moskovitz, would have none of it. Moskovitz was outstanding, making numerous jarring tackles and putting a bold rush on the Neshaminy quarterbacks all night.

The Bensalem win spoiled the Hall of Fame night for the Redskins' faithful.

It was, however, a big night for the Owls. Minnichbach summed it up by saying, "To win a game in the Suburban One Power Ten is a big victory for our program."

Coach Mark Schmidt begins his career as Redskin Head Coach after spending ten years in the college ranks. Most recently, Schmidt served five seasons as Offensive Line Coach and Recruiting Coordinator at Lock Haven University. There he was instrumental in implementing the Run & Shoot offense, which was nationally ranked during his last three seasons. As Recruiting Coordinator, Schmidt was no stranger to the Suburban One Conference, actively recruiting high school players throughout Southeastern Pennsylvania, Southern New Jersey and Delaware.

Prior to Lock Haven, Schmidt coached under Jerry Berndt at Temple University and the University of Pennsylvania. At Penn, the team earned Ivy League Championship honors both seasons he was there. He also was a

Tight End Coach under Jerry Claiborne at the University of Kentucky.

Schmidt's first coaching experiences actually came in the Suburban One Conference, when in 1982 and 1983, he coached under the direction of close friend and Norristown Area High School head coach Roger Grove. During those years, Norristown won back-to-back Suburban One Conference Championships.

A graduate of Lower Moreland High School, Schmidt earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physical Education from Ursinus College, where he was an All-Conference linebacker. Schmidt and his wife Maribeth reside in Hatboro, Pennsylvania.

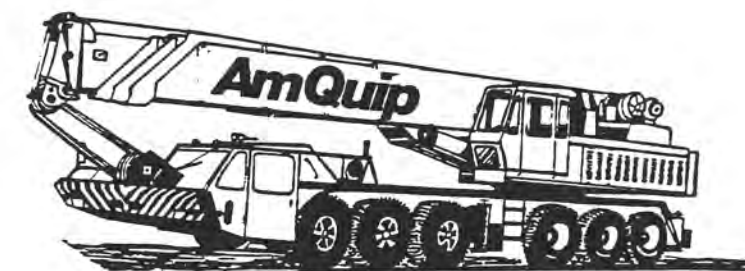

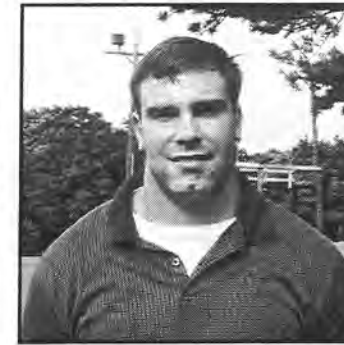
Dave Coll - Athletic Trainer

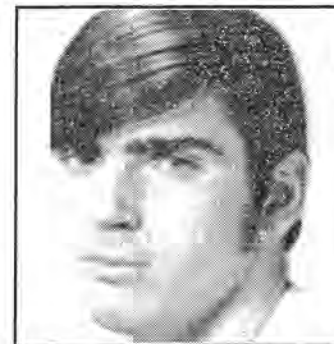
NESHAMINY FOOTBALL 1995 INDUCTEES

LT.COL. DAVE PYLE '69-'70-'71



Dave played halfback his sophomore year, roving linebacker in 11th grade, and middle guard/ middle linebacker in 12th grade. He was named All-Lower Bucks, All-Area, and second team Big-7 in addition to earning a place in the Big-33 game. Dave was the recipient of the "Unsung Hero." He played football at West Point until being sidelined by injury. Lt. Col. Pyle is presently the Battalion Commander of Military Intelligence, overseeing units from Texas to Kuwait. He lives with his two teenage sons in Augusta, Georgia and enjoys running, tennis and reading.

VANCE FORCHETTI '68-'69-'70



A tough linebacker, Vance inspired the Championship Redskins (Coached by Jack Schwartz) with his big tackles. He was named to the All Lower Bucks Team, the All Area Team, and the All Big-7 Team. Vance has taught at University of Southern Mississippi, University of Georgia, Oklahoma State and at Rider. He also owns a restaurant and still does behavioral research. He lives with his wife, Pam, and four children in Yardley.

ROBERT DUMONT '76-'77-'78



Bob Dumont played football for three years at Maple Point HS under head coach John Chaump. Twice named All-Area and All-League linebacker and defensive end, Bob was a significant force in leading the Cougars to the playoffs. He was also named third team All-State, averaging more than eight tackles per game. Coach Chaump noted, "that nobody even wanted to try to get around our end with Dumont playing the position as well as he did." His scholastic football career was followed by a successful career at Rutgers University. A real estate developer, Bob lives in Langhorne with his wife, Lisa, and two children.

RAY KELLY DISTINGUISHED SERVICE HONOREE



From 1979 Ray served as the Neshaminy High School Athletic Director, until he was named Principal of Maple Point Middle School in 1993. During those fourteen years Ray is credited with moving the Redskin football facilities and program to its present place of prominence. Working with the "N" Club, Ray Kelly implemented the new scoreboard, concession stand and bathrooms, weightroom, team locker room, and coaches' office.

In addition, we honor Ray for starting the Football Hall of Fame along with Harry Franks and the "N" Club. Ray enjoys coaching POP warner football and spending time with his wife Pat and their four children. Ray credits the great Neshaminy family with his success, noting that his "relationships with the kids over the years had made it all worthwhile."

HALL OF FAME

RICHARD LUKENS '44-'45-'46



Richard played halfback on the first championship team of Langhorne Middletown High School (Maple and Cherry Streets). The team, known as the Playwickians, was coached by Mike DeRisi, and lead by captain "Inky" Schneider. Richard started his scholastic grid career as a center, but switched to halfback for his junior and senior years. He was named All-County halfback in 1946. The Advance newspaper noted that, "Dick Lukens, the South Langhorne (Penndel) running back has been one of the best running backs on the squad...raking up three touchdowns in the championship game against Morrisville, 46-0." This Hall of Fame honor is awarded posthumously and will be received by Mr. Luken's family.



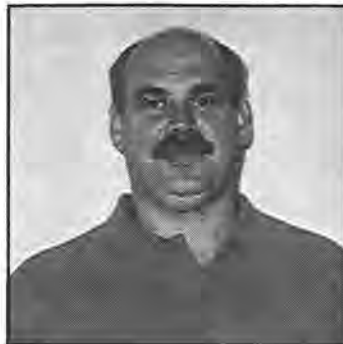
DR. GARY LATHAM '51-'52

Gary played quarterback and defensive back and lead his 1952 squad, coached by Harry Franks, to the Bucks County Championship. He was named to both the All-Area and All-League teams. Gary turned down a football scholarship to Brown University to study physica at Penn State noting that, "I dreamed about playing football for many years afterward." Dr. Latham is a geophysicist with the U.S. Department of Energy and resides with his family in Maryland.



GEORGE RUMSEY '54-'55-'56

Twice named to the All-League and All-Area as an end and halfback, George Rumsey also made the All-Philadelphia Area team as a back. In a television interview Mr. Rumsey reffered to the teams coached by Harry Franks saying, "Neshaminy never gives up...that last year we started out with three straight losses and came right back to win the championship. We have no outstanding stars on our team. That's the way it should be." George recently retired after 33 years in education, the last 23 as a school principal. He lives in Maryland and still follows Delaware football where he played on scholarship.



EDWARD ROMANOWSKI '67-'68-'69

During his three years, Ed played eight different positions in addition to punting and kicking. He made the All-Lower Bucks team and second team All-Area as fullback/ halfback. He was also named Mr. Back and Scholar Athlete. Ed averaged four yards per carry on Jack Schwartz's team. He earned a football scholarship to the University of Delaware. Looking back at his days at Neshaminy Romanowski cites the victory over Egan and a 60 yard TD run against Pennsbury as his biggest gridiron thrills. Ed is a business consultant and resides in Holland with his wife Cynthia and two children.
