


### Dave Woodley/Weightlifting



#### **Fun Facts**

Blue and Red – How Did That Come About? The colors for our cherished Redskins (and all the sports team as well). Simple: Way back when (in the early part of the twentieth century) the University of Pennsylvania used to hold their summer practices in the Langhorne area (we'd guess that was to escape the heat of the city). Well, rumor has it they may have lined up on the athletic field of the old Langhorne-Middletown High School. So when it came time to generate a little school spirit (you know, get a mascot, and pick some school colors) do you have any idea what came to mind? How about the Penn Quakers and their blue and red color scheme!

**Mr. Redskin:** In 1952 (at the end of his first season as Head Coach) Harry Franks decided there was a need to recognize a player each year that embodied a set of all-around qualities of character that all Redskins could look up to. These are:

- He should be the best all-around football player;
- He should be the best all-around citizen;
- He should be the most cooperative team mate with the other players and the coaches; and
- He should display sportsmanship, conditioning, and a general attitude which were, at all times, good for the team. Although those four "ideals" might seem quaint in today's world, we think they're just as applicable now as they were back then.

#### September 2015, marks the 59th year of football at Heartbreak Ridge

September 7, 1956 – The opening contest against Hatboro-Horsham sees the first game played at Neshaminy's new field called the "Neshaminy Athletic Field" or "Playwicki Field" (as the old Cherry Street field was called as well). It's a night game as lights had been installed with the seating being the "old" style wooden and steel bleachers. Harry Franks had purchased the lights and stands from a bankrupt Reading minor league baseball team. He then hired a crew to dismantle it all, had it brought to Langhorne and then reassembled in time for the season (that included jamming telephone poles near the field that were then used to mount the lights).

**November 10, 1965** - It was Dick Dougherty of the Bristol and Courier Times, who first hung the title "Heartbreak Ridge" on the 'Skins home field in a weekly column he wrote on scholastic sports in the Delaware Valley.

1985: Neshaminy School District appropriately renamed its athletic venue as "Harry E. Franks Stadium".

July 16, 2015 - LED lights were installed making the Redskins the first High School on the East Coast to have them!
