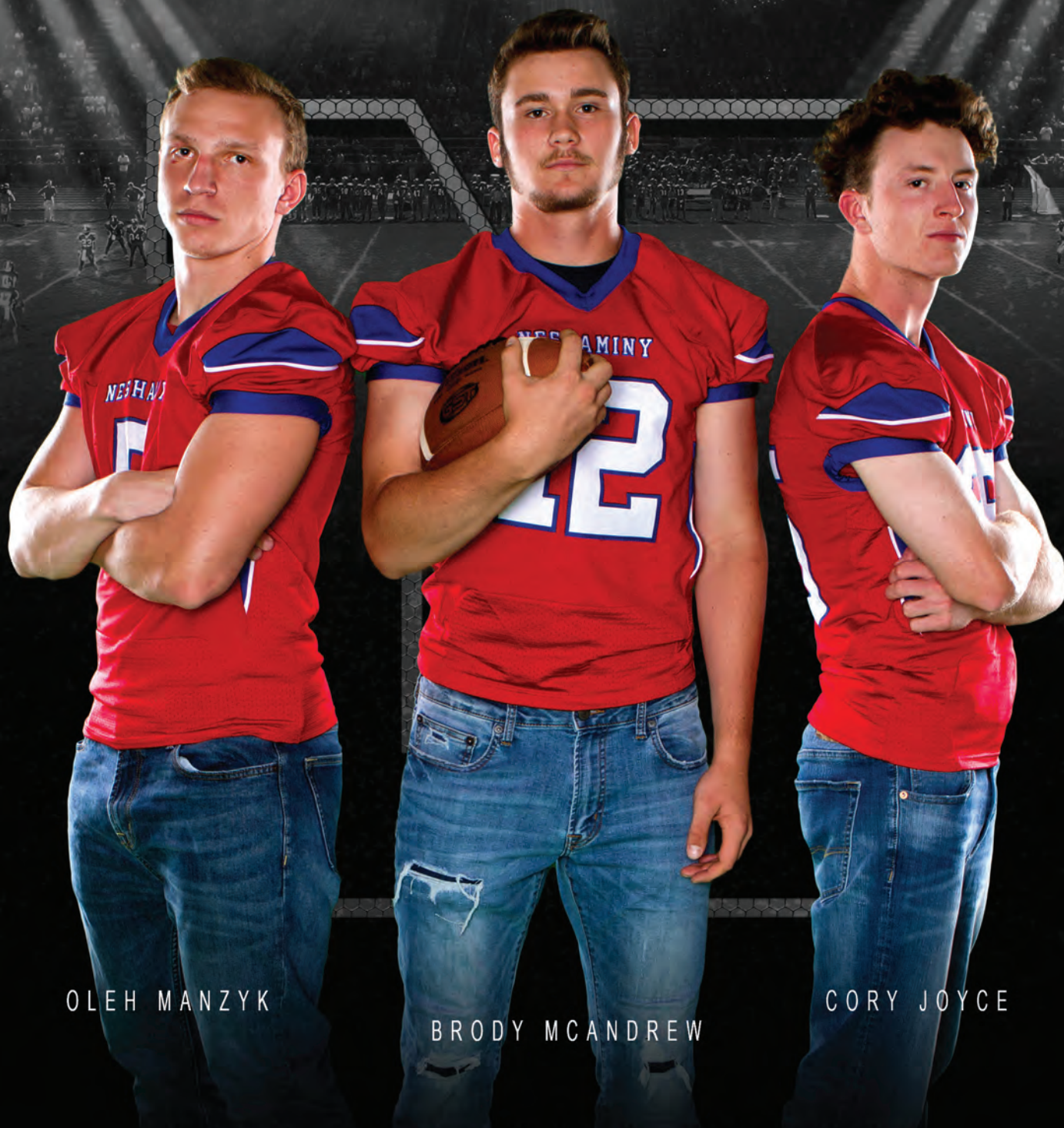

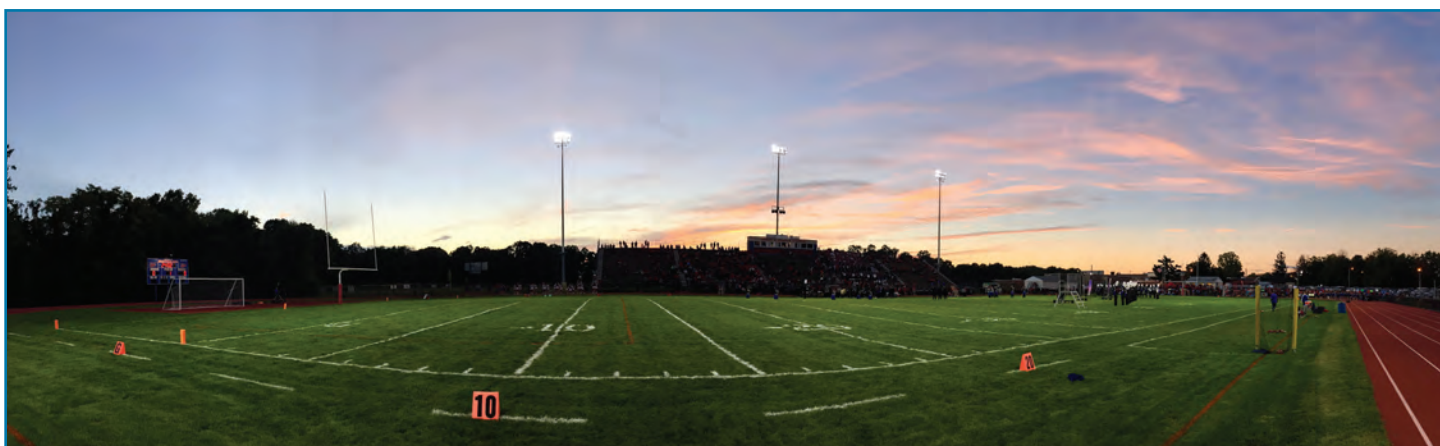
Luke Carrezola - Defensive Line
