Neshaminy High School

Tonight the Allen Canaries meet the Neshaminy Redskins, the Interscholastic Powerhouse of Lower Bucks County. Neshaminy is one of the biggest jointures in Levittown, Pa.

In the two previous meetings of these two schools, each team has a win to its credit. Coach John Peteruskie begins his second year as head coach and had six previous years as assistant to Harry Franks who took over the Director of Athletics after leading the Redskins to their position as Interscholastic Football "Juggernaut".

Coach "Cuskie" lost 14 lettermen from last year's undefeated team but has 22 veterans returning. Team is built around 4 men who are 2 year letter winners, Tailback Ed Kuminski, 3 TD's against Chester; Tackles, 6', 210 lb. Dick Bonsall, and 6'3, 205 lb. John Carber. End 6'1, 190 lb. Bill Schenberg.

STADIUM SERVICE

The Athletic Council of Allentown School District is anxious to render the maximum service to the patrons of our Stadium. This includes those in the ticket office, ushers, police, vendors, and other attendants on game days. Our patrons will find most of their questions answered below.

RETIRING ROOMS

These are located as follows: Inside each gate excepting gate 4 (East Turner St.) which is located to the left of said entrance. The entrances are properly marked.

EMERGENCY CALLS

In case of emergency, a call to the Manager's Office Phone will enable our Public Address system to announce to the spectators in the stands — only important emergency calls will be honored. — Phone HE 3-3727 —

AUTOMOBILE PARKING

Three parking areas are provided as follows:

- (1) South of Stadium along each side of Pepsi-Cola plant.
- (2) West of Stadium practice field entering from Linden St. (opposite lake.)
- (3) West of Stadium gate No. 3 entering from 22nd St. on two sides.

LOST AND FOUND ARTICLES

Should you lose an article while attending a game, call at ticket Mgrs. Office, Field House. After each game employees of the stadium gather articles left by the spectators and turn them over to the ticket department. We also request that spectators finding articles deliver them to the Mgrs. office promptly. Any Lucky Nos. will be honored at same office.

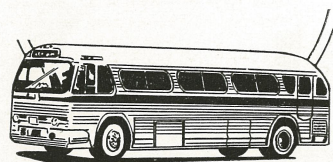
SPORTSMANSHIP CREED
