



**As The Whistle Blows**

the Redskins, Lower Bucks County Champions for the tenth consecutive year, play host to our new-found friends from lower New Jersey—the Lions of Delaware Township (near Merchantville). Neshaminy will initiate relations with a football game at 2 p.m. and a cross-country race during the halftime. Check your program for both lineups.

Our guests today just clinched their second consecutive Olympic Conference Championship last Saturday by stopping Glassboro (1-6) by the score 12-7. Delaware Township sports a respectable 5 wins and 2 losses over the season—5-0 in the league—and will work from the T-formation.

Neshaminy fans can expect to watch a well-coached Lion eleven and may pay particular attention to the work of quarterback Alfred Chmielewski and halfback Gerald McNee. We look for the air to be filled with passes from Chmielewski to Ed Butler or end Bill Duble. Scouting reports also give considerable respect for the defensive unit of Delaware Township.

For our friends from New Jersey who have never heard of the Neshaminy Redskins, here is our story. The Redskins have won or tied for the Lower Bucks County Championship for the past ten years, winning 87 times, losing 12, and tying twice. We play the single-wing type of offense (our quarterback does not handle the ball on every play) and we are extremely proud of our defensive line called the "Savages." The big question to be answered is how strong is our league and your conference. While the Lower Bucks league may not be a haven for football powerhouses, the Redskins have held their own outside the league with teams like Easton, Allentown, Chester and other strong Pennsylvania football machines.

Our fans like to see good football and all reports seem to indicate that is just what they have in store for themselves this afternoon. What happens when the champions of two leagues meet head on, we'll find out today . . .
