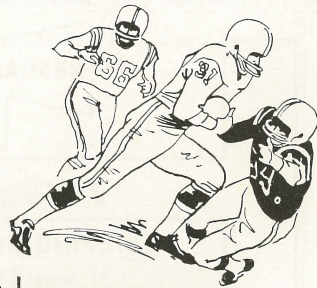
**PLAYER OF THE WEEK . . . . . ROBERT BAXTER**

A great asset to the Neshaminy team we congratulate you. . . . .

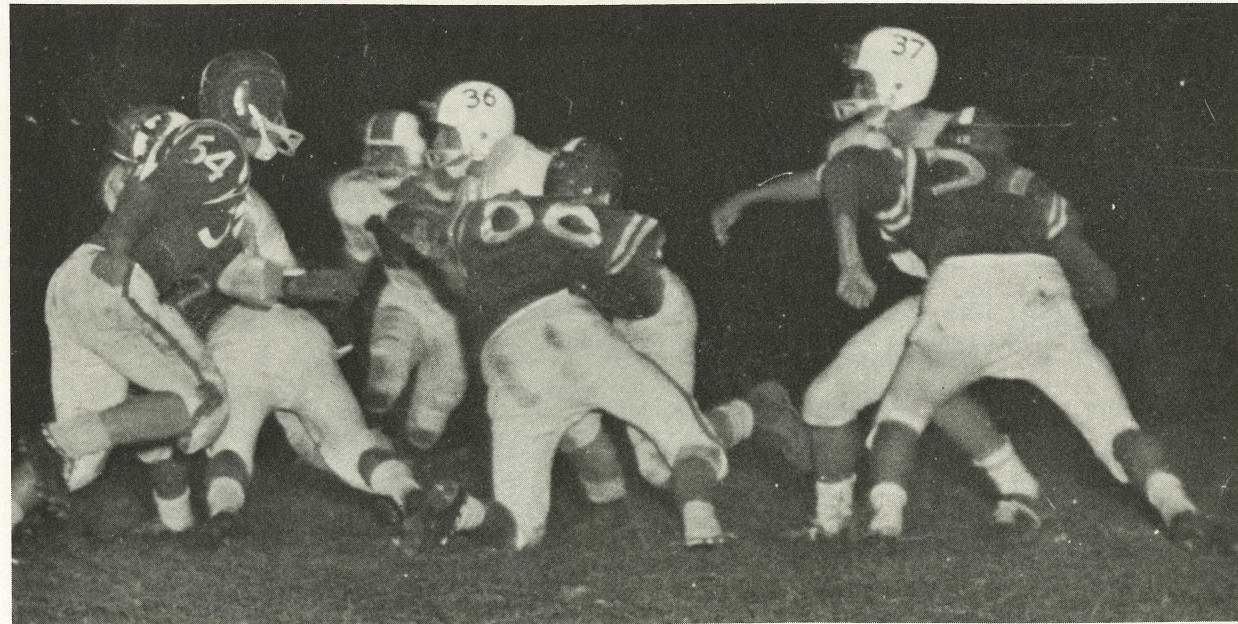

At Edinboro State Teachers' College, Praetzel played varsity basketball and coached the J.V. Team. Before stepping into the head position at Neshaminy, he coached the Neshaminy J.V.'s.

### A Look at the Team . . . . .

Last year, supposedly a nothing year, the Neshaminy Roundballers posted a very commendable 15-7 win-loss record. In league play the team placed second to Woodrow Wilson, posting a 13-3 league record.
