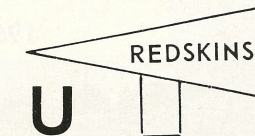
PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Tonight

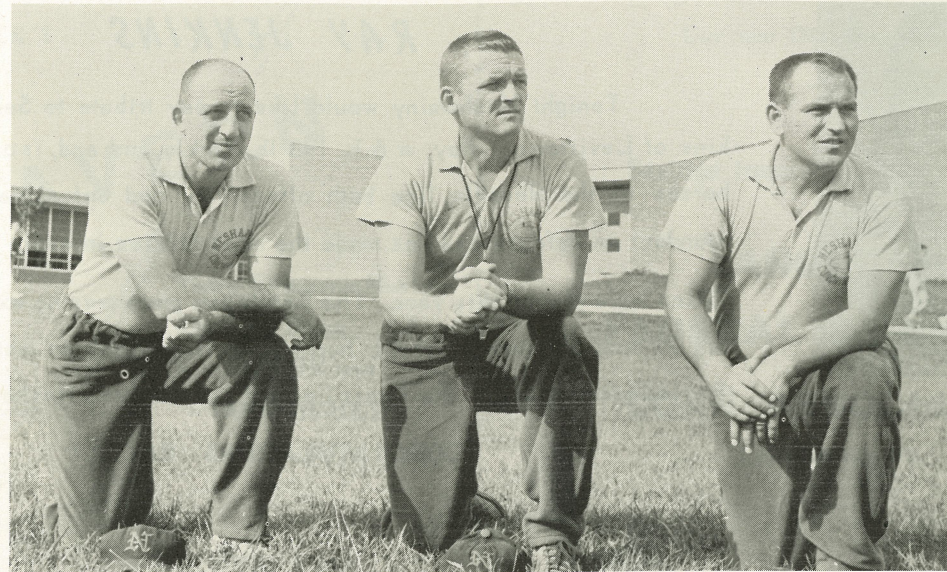

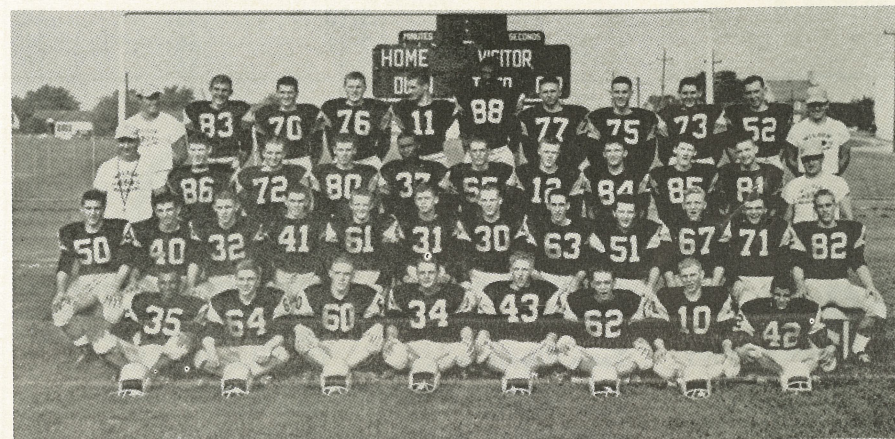
WOODROW WILSON HIGH SCHOOL

Woodrow Wilson High School is a modern educational plant situated at the corner of Mill Creek Road and Green Lane, in Levittown, Pennsylvania.

Woodrow Wilson High School has many unique construction features. Every classroom faces one of thirteen landscaped courtyards, five of which are actually enclosed within the building. The school is divided into three areas. "A" area contains the auditorium, offices, science laboratories and Home Economics suite. "B" area houses math, social studies, English, foreign language classrooms, the library, and a student publications room. The gymnasium, natatorium, art classrooms, graphic arts, wood and metal shops, and business education classrooms are located in the "C" area. North-south hallways run in the one story structure from one end to the other. East-west corridors are divided into three sections. "B" wing corridors face "A" wing and "C" area courtyards while "A" and "C" area corridors face "B" wing courtyards. This eliminated the carrying of sound from classrooms containing noisy machinery.

The athletic facilities at Woodrow Wilson High School include a baseball diamond with seating for 2,000, a hockey field, a practice football field, 2 soccer fields, 3 softball fields, 4 outdoor basketball courts, 4 tennis courts and a cross country course. The football stadium, with a seating capacity of 5,500, is surrounded by a 440 yard cinder track with an 8 lane 220 yard straight-away.
