

GREAT PUMPKIN'S PREDICTIONS COME TRUE

Last Saturday afternoon, as a standing-room-only crowd of 10,000 looked on at Pennsbury a fired up defense unit — The Savages — forced the highly touted Falcon offensive machine to give up the football twice in the first quarter of play. It took only five plays for Neshaminy to score the first time the Redskins got the ball with Billy Kaminski going 39 yards off tackle to score. The first of George Nolte's two placements made it 7-0.

Five minutes later the Redskins had the ball again and Jimmie Colbert fired an 11 yard pass to Andy Irons who gained another 27 yards before being tackled at the two yard line. On the next play Colbert sneaked over and Neshaminy led 14-0, with Nolte's kick. Pennsbury scored once in the second quarter and again in the fourth but failed to make good on its second extra point attempt when Burkhart was stopped short of the goal line.

The victory gives Neshaminy the distinction of winning the Lower Bucks and the East Penn Crown two years in a row.

Let's welcome Delhaas — in what appears to be the last meeting between the two schools, the Redskins hope to finish another season undefeated. Delhaas comes to Neshaminy Senior High School Stadium fresh from a 7-6 victory over William Tennent last Saturday afternoon. . .
