Dietz collected 186 of his passing yards in the first half. He threw a 25yard touchdown pass to senior Ja-son Jonigkeit in the first quarter and a 60-yard scoring bomb to jun-ior Antoine Lovelace late in the sec-

ord quarter. The Redskins, however, allowed Riddick to romp for 100 yards in the first 24 minutes, and by 14-12 at the half.

by 14-12 at the half. Victimizing Neshaminy's inexpe-rienced defensive line, the Huskies opened the second half by march-ing 76 yards on 11 plays. Riddick's 34-yard touchdown burst gave Die-ruff an 18-14 lead.

In the fourth quarter, the Red-skins atoned somewhat for the 288 skins atoned somewhat for the 288 rushing yards they allowed in the game. They forced four turnovers in the contest, including Mike Kel-ly's interception at the Neshaminy 29 in the final minute to stave off Dieruff's comeback bid.
