

Council Rock comes from behind to pin a 13-3 loss on Neshaminy

Council Rock, ranked No. 3 in Southeastern Pennsylvania by The Inquirer entering last night's game at Neshaminy, erased a 3-0 deficit in the final period to hand the winless Redskins (0-3, 0-2) a 13-3 defeat in a Suburban One League National Conference football game.

The Indians (3-0, 2-0), who lost standout running back Mike Erlandson to a season-ending ankle injury last week against North Penn, were helped by a defense that produced three interceptions.
