

The Flons Eye Bank of Delaware Valley serves southeastern Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware. Technicians at the Eye Bank are notified when an eye donor has died and they travel to the hospital to retrieve the eyes. Eye Bank technicians perform tests on the donor eyes to ensure that there has been no exposure to an infections disease, such as a virus, which could be passed to the recipient. The condition of each cornea is evaluated and the tissue is designated for transplantation or training and research purposes, depending on its condition.

DID YOU KNOW???

- Corneal transplantation was the first type of transplant surgery performed in 1905.
- Each year in the United States, 40,000 people receive corneal transplants, while an additional 5,000 people must be put on waiting lists because of donor shortages.
- Corneal transplant surgery is the most successful type of transplant surgery. Over 90 percent of corneal transplant operations are successful and restore sight.

WHO CAN BE AN EYE DONOR?

Anyone can become an eye donor. Age is no barrier and it doesn't matter if you wear glasses or have an eye condition. Most eve diseases do not affect the cornea, so even if you have a condition such as glaucoma or retinal disorder, you can still be an eye donor.

HOW CAN I BECOME AN EYE DONOR?

Complete the large portion of the attached pledge card and return it to the Lions Eye Bank of Delaware Valley. Make sure you keep the completed, small portion of the card with you at all times. Inform your family that you have pledged your eyes and any additional tissues or organs and that you want to have your wishes carried out.

LEADER DOGS FOR THE BLIND - ROCHESTER, MICHIGAN

Leader Dogs for the Blind was founded in 1939 by a group of Michigan Lions to train dogs to lead blind persons and provide facilities and means whereby blind persons may obtain Leader Dogs. The nonprofit organization is served by a national board of 30 trustees.

People with less than normal vision, over 16 years of age, in good health, emotionally stable and of good moral character may be eligible for Leader Dog training. The students live under constant supervision of competent instructors during a four week training period. An instructor and housemother are on duty at all times. Training is conceived as a re-education emotionally and physically to a new way of effective living.

After a period of "getting acquainted" with his/her Leader Dog, the student is taken to the small, quiet town of Rochester where actual pedestrian training is begun. In progressive stages adjustment to more hazardous traffic conditions is accomplished through training on busy streets, in the heavy traffic and the hurrying crowds of Birmingham and Royal Oak, Michigan & Detroit.

At the end of four weeks training with a Leader Dog, the hesitant blind student is changed to an erect confident person who had challenged and conquered one of life's severest handicaps.

A Leader Dog enjoys its superiority. It is not just a dog, it is a Leader Dog, capable of making decisions that protect the safety of the owner. The fledgling dog must be from one to two years old, in good condition and willing to accept responsibility. Dogs must be positively friendly even to strangers. German Shepherds, Labradors and Golden Retrievers are commonly trained as Leaders. All dogs are contributed. Leader Dogs know the rules of safety. Stop-Look-Listen- then cross the street briskly. Leaders are taught to respect traffic, vehicular and pedestrian, and will respond to the given command only when the way is clear. Most dog owners say the dog is a family pet and romps with the children but the instant they put on the harness the dog is all business.

If you know anyone who could use a Leader Dog, contact your local Lions Club. The training as a student, food, lodging, and the Leader Dog are all at no cost to a qualified blind person. Usually, transportation to the school and back is paid for by the Lions Club.

BEACON LODGE CAMP FOR THE BLIND

Beacon Lodge is situated on State Route 103, two miles southwest of Newton Hamilton, PA, along the beautiful Juniata River. The hills and mountains of Central Pennsylvania surround the camp, making it a secluded place for those that require rest and an atmosphere to enjoy the activities of a camp program.

The camp occupies a 567 acre estate through which flows a babbling brook. The Main Lodge where the women campers are housed, is a twenty-eight room structure with comfortable sleeping quarters for forty persons. The dining hall, with seating accommodations for 150, and the large modern kitchen are also located in the Main Lodge. The large living room with a huge fireplace, a piano, and an electric organ is a favorite spot for adult campers. The room has a balcony with a braille library and talking books. Close by is Tarentum Hall with a snack bar and a second floor with facilities for fifteen persons. Female campers and staff are housed here. 14B Dormitory is a one floor cement block structure with accommodations for 48 male campers and staff. 14B Dormitory has accommodations for four married couples. The infirmary consists of nurses quarters, dispensary, and rooms for patients assigned, and married couples.

In Childrens Village there are twelve cement block cabins well ventilated and screened with complete bathroom facilities in each cabin and individual storage cabinets for personal items. Each cabin will accommodate 6 children and their counselors. A larger building provides kitchen and dining room facilities. It is also a food storage building, and living quarters with an office for the unit director. In the summer of 1975, a brand new air conditioned infirmary with nurses quarters and a boys and girls ward was dedicated to the late Paul Mahady, a Pennsylvania State Senator and a Past International Director of Lions.

This year a new activity building will be opened in the village. A physician in nearby Mount Union is available at the camp and the modern Huntingdon and Lewistown Hospitals are also available in time of need.

All guests are free to do the things they enjoy most. Beacon Lodge attempts to satisfy two types of campers. Those who want to rest and relax among old friends and to make new ones. Those who prefer a more active type of vacation may select a program of varied activities. There is a choice of motorboating, rowing, hiking, shuffleboard, roller skating, bowling, campfire programs, picnics, overnight hikes, mountain climbing, bus rides, baseball (with a beeping ball), wrestling, field events, bike riding, shopping tours, arts & crafts, dancing, and swimming. You must visit the camp to truly appreciate it. The 42 members of the Board of Directors are very proud that they have been able to keep the weekly fee to \$125.00 The actual cost is \$280,00 per week. Many Lions Districts pick up the tab for utilities and maintenance, thus enabling the camp to operate at such a low fee.



HEARING CONSERVATION / HEARING RESEARCH

A quotation from Helen Keller. . . .

"Deafness, by fettering the powers of utterness, cheats many a persons birthright to knowledge. How can people pick up words and weigh their value if they lack the foundation on which knowledge is built?"

Hearing Conservation revenue supports the following:

- 1. Provide hearing examinations for needy children and adults alike.
- 2. Provide hearing testing equipment for schools, clinics, etc.
- 3. Provide medical or surgical services.
- 4. Furnish, repair, or replace hearing-aids when necessary for hard of hearing children and adults.
- 5. Provide needy individuals with batteries, aids, and special devices.
- 6. Furnish equipment for classroom use with hearing impaired children.
- 7. Provide financial assistance to families with hearing impaired children in need of special education.
- 8. Provide video tapes, films, etc. for deaf individuals.
- 9. Assist with vocational and employment services.

Hearing Research collects money to award grants for the best proposals submitted by doctors, hospitals, and universities in order to improve all aspects of the hearing problems.

CAMP KIRBY

Camp Kirby sprawls over rolling fields and woodlands, high above the Delaware River, in beautiful historic Bucks County. It is located in Upper Black Eddy, 35 miles north of Philadelphia on route 611. At Ferndale Hotel, turn right, drive three miles to Camp Kirby.

Camp Kirby was designed to meet a definite need. The proper educational and recreational facilities are available for the hearing handicapped campers. A professional staff of experienced counselors assist and train the campers.

Trips are taken to nearby sites where pages from their history books come alive through the interpretation of counselors trained in teaching the hearing handicapped. Each boy or girl's education will grow in a Summer Camping environment.

Overnight campouts create an atmosphere of fun, excitement, the thrill of spotting deer at night and seeing other wildlife. These experiences not only are shared around the campfires, but memories to cherish for years to come.

As each camper participates in various activities, an educational program involving the language and vocabulary of camp life is pre-sented by counselors. Hiking, volleyball, swimming, riflery, cookouts, riding and nature lore are a few of the many activities to help enrich the camper's life.

Free time to participate in individual activities such as gold, fishing and archery help teach self-responsibility and self-discipline.

Camp Kirby consists of 27 acres and has a stream running through the land. The camp has its own well for water. The physical facilities include the following:

six cabins for campers infirmary bathrooms for boys & girls w/showers large living room office

recreation room fireplace with outdoor grill swimming pool home for caretaker cabin for director

NEWTOWN - Council Rock High School football coach Mike Ortman has been involved in enough of these Bucks County All-Star football games to know how much fun they can be. Bensalem coach Biz Keeny will be finding out for the first time.

But both men know they will have a ton of talent to work with when practices begin late next

Ortman and his staff will coach the North, and Keeny and his staff will guide the South at the 27th annual Bucks County Lions Clubs Bob Sands Memorial All-Star Football Game. Council Rock, which added stadium lights before last season, will host the game for the first time on Saturday, June 6, at 7:30 p.m.

The game is about showcasing the best senior football talent in Bucks County. But it's also about raising money for charity.

In the 22 years the Lions Club has sponsored the game, it has

raised more than \$275,000 in charity. Last year's game raised \$17,000, including more than \$4,000 for the

Bucks County Blind Association.
The North leads the series, 16-7-3, and has won five of the last seven games. The teams tied, 28-28. last year.

This will be Ortman's fourth time as head coach. He went 0-2

with the South when he was head coach at Morrisville, and he led the North to a 20-12 victory as Rock coach in 1992.

"The neatest part is getting to coach kids you've game planned against during the year," Ortman said. "You don't have to hide any bodies out there. Most of the players are real top-caliber kids, and a large majority of them will play ball in college."

One star Ortman won't get the

chance to coach is CB West's Dave Armstrong, who opted to play in the Big 33 game between Pennsylvania and Ohio All-Stars.

Keeny, who guided Bensalem to its first winning season in five years as a rookie head coach last fall, said coaching in the game will remind him of his days as a college assistant at Kutztown.

"It's almost like really being back at college," said Keeny. "We'll have pretty good players at every

The South roster appears stacked at the skill positions, with Courier Times Player of the Year Jim Dietz of Neshaminy at quarterback, Bensalem's Keith Davis at running back and a star-filled crop of receivers, led by Bensalem's Temple University-bound Krishan Lewis.

The North will counter with some dangerous skill position players of its own, including running backs Keith Crowell of William Tennent and Dan Boyle of Archbishop Wood.
