

Neshaminy 14, Father Judge 10 — The host Redskins (2-0), ranked fifth in The Inquirer's Southeastern Pennsylvania Top 10, used big plays to set up both touchdowns after Judge (1-1) went up 10-0 in the second quarter.

Neshaminy's first score — a 2-yard run by quarterback David Welsh — was set up by Welsh's earlier sneak that went for 30 yards on a broken play. Later in the second period, Bryan McGinty returned a punt 38 yards to set up Neshaminy's second TD, which came on a 16-yard run by Rafael Wrigley with 1:41 left in the half.
