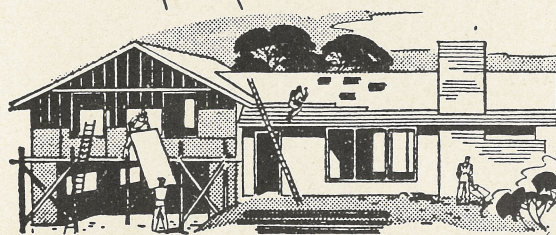

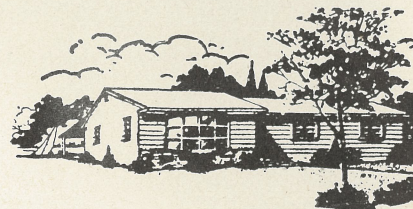

REDSKINS REVIEWS #2 AND #3

LaSalle rallies to tie Skins: — Neshaminy almost had its first win as they bounced back from the Egan loss. Following a scoreless first half QB Ernie Forchetti plunged over the goal line for six points with just 31 seconds remaining in the third quarter. The extra point attempt failed. (Neshaminy 6 - LaSalle 0). Early in the fourth quarter LaSalle drove to the Neshaminy 25 where Dave Rakita intercepted a pass and went 75 yards for the Redskins second T.D. Bruce Sauerbry booted the extra point—Neshaminy 13 - LaSalle 0.

With less than five minutes showing on the clock LaSalle scored twice, once on a 35 yard pass and again on a 3 yard plunge. Final score Neshaminy 13 - LaSalle 13.

Easton: — Neshaminy suffered its first loss in the Big "6" as the Red Rovers downed the Redskins 13 - 0. All the scoring took place in the first half as Easton's All-State prospect John Cappellano broke off tackle and went 37 yards to score with 5 minutes left in the first quarter. Cappellano's extra point attempt failed.

The Redskins drive following the kickoff was cut short by a fumble and Easton padded its lead to 13-0 early in the second period as Jones scored on a two yard plunge. Final score 13 - 0.

Welcome Wm. Allen: — Tonight we are happy to welcome the Canaries from Wm Allen High School. Coach Halfacre's boys are presently sitting atop the Big "6" league with Easton as a result of their 20-13 upset of Pennsbury last week. We fans and officials can expect to see the ball in the air as Allen's Radcliffe is a fine passing QB. — However a win for the Redskins would throw the Big "6" wide open —

Speaking of officials: — "I had this halfback," drawls Jack Curtice, "fastest starting back in Texas. So fast he was always drawing penalties for being in motion. One day I told the official to watch the boy closely and he'd see that the boy wasn't jumping the gun - he was just getting away like a jet.

"On the very next play the official penalized us again. I screamed that the boy wasn't in motion.
" 'No, he wasn't' the coach told me, 'this penalty is on the rest of the team for delaying the game.' "

Probable Starting Line-Up - Defense

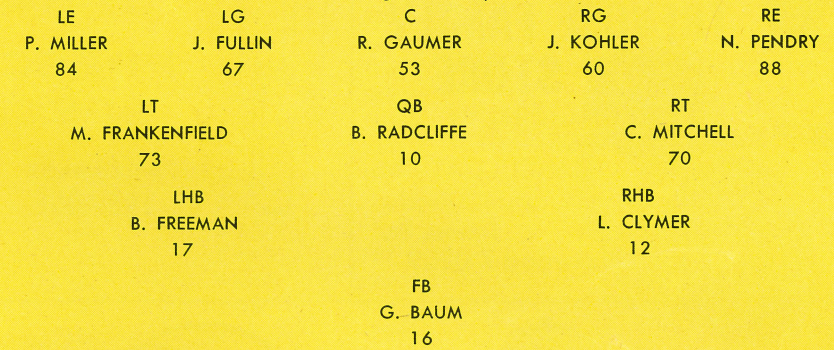
