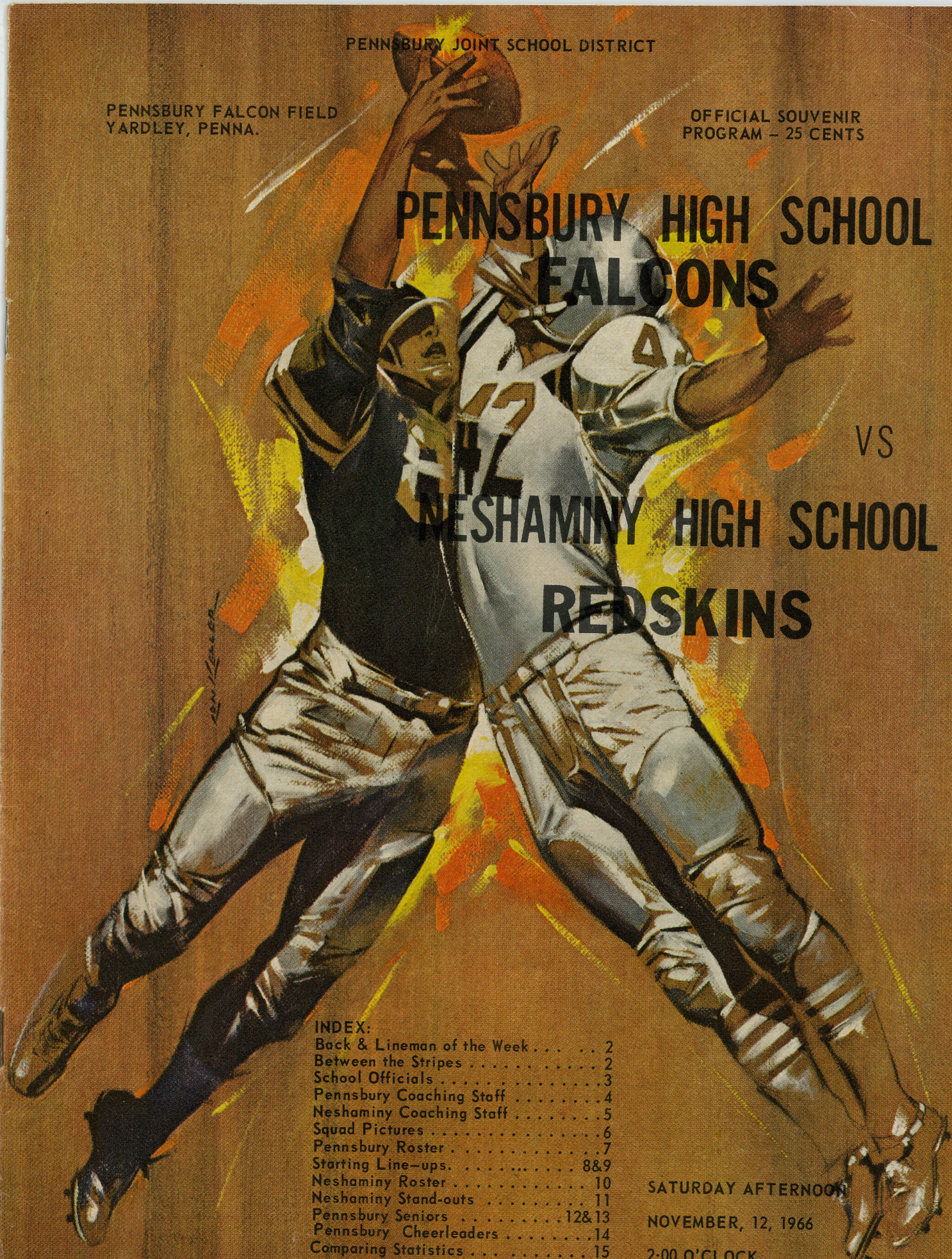

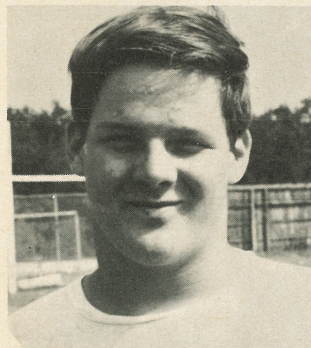

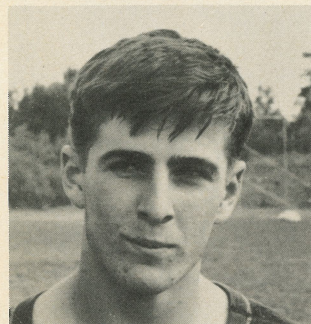

**Last Week . . . . .**

The high flying Falcons rolled over the Panthers of Wm. Tennent 58 to 6. This is the second time this year that Pennsbury has hit the 50 mark. The Panthers were just no match for the Falcons. This game showed the Pennsbury fans the power of the Falcons who scored 8 touchdowns. It also showed the fans what the underclassman forces looked like. Pennsbury rolled up 435 yards on the ground and 119 yards in the air for 554 yards and 24 first downs. Scoring for the Falcons were Ed McManus 3, Bill Noah 2, Bob Reed, Jeff Edelson, Bill Evans and Ira Williams. Extra points were kicked by John Stasi 3 and Rich Orwig 1.

**This Afternoon . . . . .**

Pennsbury would like to welcome the Redskins of Neshaminy High School to Falcon Field. These two teams have enjoyed some of the finest football rivalry in the state. However Pennsbury has not defeated Neshaminy since 1957. Over the last three years Neshaminy has won 21-20, 14-13 and last year 7-0. As everyone knows Neshaminy has been one of the big football powers in the state for years, winning the Big Six Conference every year and winning the Lower Bucks League more times than people can remember. This year the Redskins are having an off year with a record of 2-5-2. In comparing the two teams Pennsbury defeated Altoona 21-15 and lost to Wm. Allen 20-13 while Neshaminy lost to Altoona last week 33-6 and tied Allen 19-19 early in the season. This is the Skins final game of the season while the Falcons have Wilson next Friday.

Prior to his Pennsbury job, Mr. Baugher was Head Coach at Ambler High School for 13 years. During this time Ambler High School was undefeated Bux-Mont Champions four times and runner-up four times. Mr. Baugher's over-all record both at Ambler High School and Pennsbury High School is 131 wins - 34 losses 9 ties. His record at Pennsbury now stands at 34 - 10 - 3.



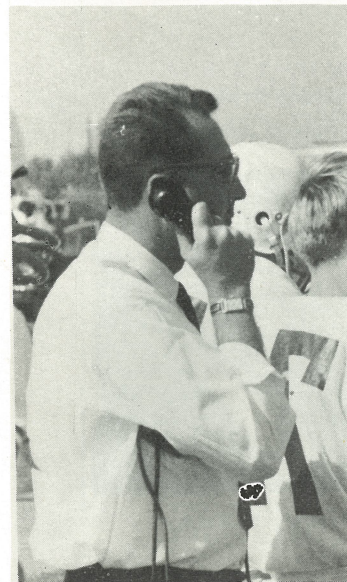
