Probable Starting Line-Up - Defense



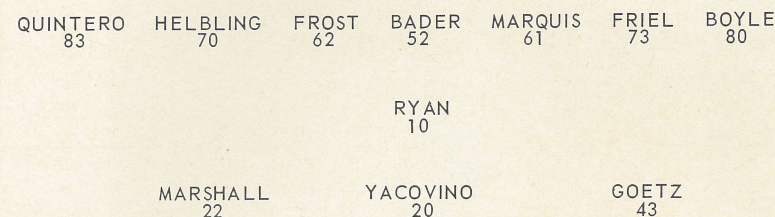
