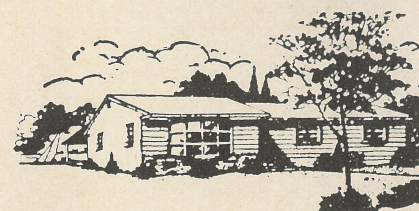

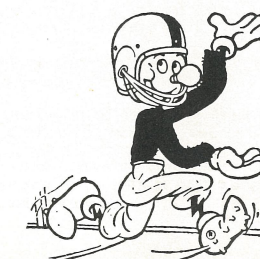


**REDSKIN PREVIEW #1**
