

14,000 See Neshaminy Trip Allen

ALLENTOWN — Neshaminy High School of Langhorne is still handing out free lessons in football.

The Redskins showed anyone who was interested (and 14,000 fans were) how to blend a hard-running offense with a rock-ribbed defense when they clashed with host William Allen High School of Allentown on Saturday night.

Neshaminy's talent-rich eleven pilled 339 yards rushing and another 40 lengths in the air to whip William Allen, 19-7, in a Big Six Football League encounter.

Tough Defense

The 'Skins were quite "tight" as far as giving the Canaries anything to sing about. Allen only picked up 27 yards rushing but managed to notch 86 more stripes in passing. And 45 of those yards came on Allen's only scoring movement.

Neshaminy is now 2-0 in the

loop and 4-0 in all games. A victory string over three seasons is 22-0-2. Neshaminy's last official setback came in 1959, not counting 11 forfeitures in 1962. Wipe away that blemish, and Neshaminy's record book shows a 42-0-3 reading.

Neshaminy uncovered a punishing running attack which ripped Allen's forward wall to shreds. Gerry Barr (6-0, 170, senior) ran like a steam engine until he received a shoulder separation just before the half. Barr piled up 73 yards on 11 carries for a 6.6 average.

He was replaced by sophomore Dick Settles (6-2, 165). Settles displayed brutal power.

He blasted into Allen's mid-section with fury and racked up 65 lengths on 13 assignments before being knocked unconscious late in the fourth period.

Both gridders were sent to the hospital but have been released. Barr is expected to be sidelined for about a week. Settles suffered a slight concussion and is awaiting a doctor's release to resume practice.

air-arm of senior Joe Tomcho (5-11, 170). His strike to half-back Pete Moggio (5-8, 160) provided Allen with a 7-7 half-time deadlock. Moggio caught a 35-yard aerial and scampered 10 more yards for the TD. Ken

Cressman's placement made it 7-7.

Initial Score

Neshaminy scored the first time it handled the pigskin. The 'Skins moved 80 yards in 11 plays with Barr going one yard for the touchdown. George Nolte's placement made it 7-0.

The 'Skins broke the stalemate in the fourth period. Settles did most of the running during a 12-play, 79-yard advance. Jim Colbert (6-2, 185, senior) chugged the last two yards.

Neshaminy's final TD march was 56 yards on just five plays. Colbert dashed 29 yards from his own 44 to the Allen 27. The play was highlighted by a jarring block by Bob Rotolo (5-10, 185, senior), Neshaminy's full-back.

Settles and Rotolo combined for 13 yards to the 14-yard line. Garry Pasquine (5-8, 190, junior) took over for Settles and spun and side-stepped the distance into the end zone. Nolte's
