

Concession

Stands Slated

More than school classrooms were considered for construction at the meeting of the Neshaminy Joint School Board last night.

A limit of \$20,000 was set on the construction of concession stands and lavatories for the Neshaminy High School football field. The architectural firm of Haag and d'Entremont was selected to design the project expected to be finished by next fall.

Considerable discussion followed after passage of the project because of a contract with the Neshaminy Junior Chamber of Commerce (Jaycees) to operate the concession stands this year.

The Jaycees will return 40 per cent of their profit to the student fund and, if there is enough money left, provide two \$500 scholarships. Some school directors argued the money should be returned to the general fund of the budget and be used to pay for the construction of the concession stands.

Also approved was a bid for constructing a parking lot by the new circular library with access to the new gym. The contract was awarded to the George R. Miller Co. of Warminster and calls for a black top surface. It must be installed before the ground freezes or patrons of the basketball team will have to park in front of the school and walk through a large part of the school buildings to reach the court.

The parking lot, which will serve 380 cars, will cost \$20,200.
