Everybody said Neshaminy switched to the T-formation this year because Bob Baxter and Bill Brundzo, two powerful single-wing runners, had graduated. But don't mention that to Jim Colbert.

Colbert, a lanky junior quarterback, tossed three touchdown passes last night as the Redskins opened their East-Central Conference campaign with a convincing 19-0 win over Easton before about 9,000 fans in Cottingham Stadium.

Colbert (6-2) hit end Dennis Auckland in the first half and then combined with Ted Kaminsky for a pair of second-half scores as Neshaminy handed Easton its first loss after an opening-night win.

The Red Rovers were never really in the game. Their only threat came when Neshaminy fumbled a punt, and Joe Glory recovered on the Neshaminy 14. Four plays later the Redskins took over on the 5.

The first Neshaminy touchdown came with only 1:32 left in the first half when they drove 42 yards on nine plays. Colbert completed three straight passes in the march, the last one for 10 yards to Auckland for the TD.
