

# Allen Routed, 40-6, By 'Weak' Neshaminy

LANGHORNE — A supposed-ly "weaker-than-usual" Neshaminy football team scored in every period Saturday night and handed Allen its worst defeat in 31 years, trouncing the Canaries, 40-6, before some 10,000 spectators.

The Redskins, who switched from their usual single wing power to the wing-T after losing Bob Baxter and Bill Brundzo, ran up a 19-0 lead after only one period and never were pressed as they posted their fourth straight victory and second in defense of their East-Central Conference championship.

Allen, which bowed for the third time in as many games,

averted a shutout with three minutes to play when Tony Perilla went over from the 5 on a power play. His pass from Jim Woodley had set up the score at the Redskins' 20, the first touchdown against them this season.

Harrisburg Tech defeated the Canaries, then Allentown, 45-0 in 1923. The worst defeat in recent years was a 35-9 loss to Patterson Park, Md., in 1955. That's the worst defeat under Coach Perry Scott. Phillipsburg won in 1961 by 42-18.

Jim Colbert and Ted Kaminski each scored twice to lead the Redskins' onslaught, Kaminski running 90 yards with the kickoff after Allen's touchdown. He also went into the end zone on a one-yard plunge.

Colbert scored on runs of 3 and 22 yards, Ted Boerckel on a three-yard run and Jerry Barr on a 57-yard scamper in the opening quarter.
