Neshaminy Nips Pennsbury, 7-0, On Run by Barr

Gerry Barr broke loose on a 48-yard touchdown run in the fourth period Friday night as Neshaminy High's undefeated Redskins edged perennial rival Pennsbury, 7-0, in a Lower Bucks League Section 1 game before 10,000 at Langhorne.

Barr's run for glory, which ran Neshaminy's unbeaten string to 50 games over the last five years, came on the third play of a 59-yard drive following a Pennsbury punt.

It broke up a stunning duel in which both teams drove inside the five-yard line before the defenses rose to the task. The victory was Neshaminy's ninth of the year (along with one tie) and second in the league.

PENNSBURY HELD AT FIVE

Pennsbury (6-2-1 overall, 1-1-1 league) took the opening kickoff and drove 69 yards in 17 plays before losing the ball on downs at the Neshaminy five.

The Redskins followed suit with the second-half kickoff, marching 69 yards to the Pennsbury one before running out of gas. After the TD, Pennsbury got rolling again, but Neshaminy's defense came up with the big play to halt the drive at its three-yard line.
