Neshaminy Rips Tennent, 35-6, to Post 7th Victory

Neshaminy High's undefeated Redskins rolled to their seventh victory of the season Friday night, crushing visiting William Tennent, 35-6, in a Lower Bucks League Section One game at Langhorne.

The once-tied Redskins, who already have clinched their second straight East Penn Conference crown, ran their Lower Bucks record to 2-0 to set the stage for next Saturday's showdown at Pennsbury.

Pennsbury (7-0 overall, 2-0 league) plays at Abington Saturday in a non-league test.

Bill Kaminski scored two touchdowns, on a 61-yard pass from Jim Colbert and on a 75-yard run, to lead Neshaminy's attack. Other Redskin scorers were Ted Boerkel, 48, run; Colbert, one-yard plunge, and Eric Hutchinson, one, plunge.

Bensalem (3-1 league, 5-4 overall) clinched at least a tie for the Section Two crown by scoring in every period to crush Delhaas, 32-6. In an intersectional clash, Woodrow Wilson (6-2) blanked Morrisville, 32-0.

Barry Wenhold scored three touchdowns, on a 97-yard kickoff return and runs of 63 and 31 yards, to lead Souderton (6-1) to a 31-6 rout of Quakertown (4-3) in a Bux-Mont League test. Upper Moreland (2-5) scored three fourth-period TD's to hand winless Springfield (Montco) its seventh loss, 20-14.

Blair Trent scored two touchdowns and passed for another as undefeated Darby-Colwyn (6-0-1) romped to a 35-0 Suburban Four victory over Eddystone.

Bryant Mitchell tallied three times to lead Solebury School to a 28-12 Penn-Jersey Conference decision over Friends Central.
