Neshaminy Rips Bethlehem for Big Six Crown

Neshaminy High's unbeaten Redskins clinched their third straight Big Six League championship Friday night with a 34-0 rout of visiting Bethlehem before 10,000 at Langhorne.

Bob Ritolo scored two touchdowns and Jim Colbert and Jerry Barr tallied one each as the Redskins (5-0-1 over all, 3-0-1 league) built a 27-0 lead. Tom Munski scored the final TD in the third period as Neshaminy extended its undefeated streak to 44 games over five seasons.

Unbeaten Central Bucks (5-0, 4-0) rallied from a 13-0 deficit to beat defending champion Pennridge, 14-13, and take over the Bux-Mont League lead. Frank Arcade and Ken Williams scored for CB, while Jim Vasilovic kicked the two crucial extra points.
