

Neshaminy Scores 14 In 2d Half to Nip Egan

Bishop Egan High, of Levittown, served notice Friday night that it intended to be in the thick of the 1963 Philadelphia Catholic League race by outplaying Neshaminy's powerful Redskins for more than three periods before bowing by a 14-13 count.

Joe Rorick's two-yard and Tom Colella's three yard slant in the second gave Egan a 13-0 halftime lead as the visitors rolled up a 118-11 net yardage advantage.

The tide turned midway in the third period when a bad and Neshaminy took over on Egan's 36. Eight plays later Bob Baxter scored on a then kicked the extra point.
