Neshaminy Extends Streak To 33 Games

Neshaminy High School, champion of the Lower Bucks Conference, extended its unbeaten streak to 33 games when it turned back LaSalle High, of the Catholic League, 13-0, before more than 9000 at the winner's field Friday night.

It was the season's second win for Neshaminy and the second time it conquered LaSalle in three years. Last season the two fought to a scoreless tie.

Bill Hutchinson scored on a 10-yard run following the recovery of a fumbled punt on LaSalle's 20-yard line in the second quarter and Jim Colbert's 15-yard pass to Andy Irons accounted for the other tally before the half ended.
