

Pennington Edges Pennsbury to Crown, 4-13

10,000 Watch Raiders Run Streak to 55

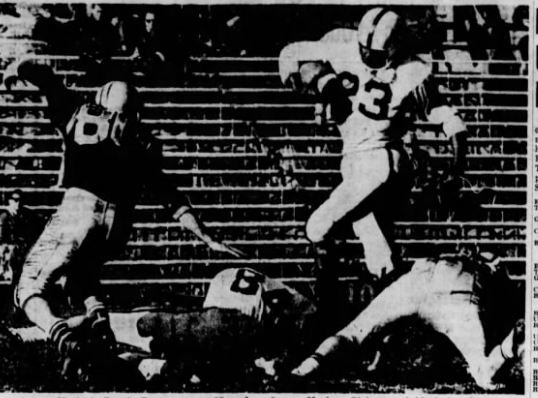
WIND FLAYS HAVOC
