

Troy Vincent, Andy Szarko and Herb White scored first-half touchdowns as host Pennsbury blanked Neshaminy, 18-0, in a Suburban One League National Conference football game yesterday.

The Falcons (8-3 overall, 6-2 league) finished in a first-place tie for the Patriot Division title with the Redskins (9-2, 6-2), the No. 3 team in The Inquirer's Southeastern Pennsylvania Top 10.

Vincent (114 yards, nine carries) scored on a 71-yard dash in the first quarter. Szarko's 1-yard TD run and White's 2-yard scoring run came in

the second period.

Pennsbury, winning its third straight game, used a nine-man defensive front to snap Neshaminy's four-game winning streak. The Redskins had previously lost to only top-ranked Central Bucks West.
