**Neshaminy 30, Abington 12** — Dave Megahan rushed for three touchdowns and added a TD reception to highlight a 30-point unanswered explosion as Neshaminy upset Abington.

Abington, ranked seventh by The Inquirer's Poll, opened a 12-0 lead on the Redskins (7-2, 5-1) in the second quarter, but Megahan countered with the first of his four scores, a 17-yard TD catch from Tim Ford, to pull Neshaminy to within 12-7 at halftime.

Megahan (11 carries, 98 yards) opened the second-half scoring with a 2-yard TD plunge, and added a 17-yard dash near the end of the third quarter to help the Redskins, who have won four straight games, take a 21-12 lead. Megahan added a 3-yard touchdown run the final period.

Bill Wagner (7 solo tackles, 3 assists) led a Neshaminy defense that closed down Abington in the second half, limiting the Galloping Ghosts (7-2, 4-2) to minus 17 yards in the final 24 minutes. Abington, which had won three straight, including a 11-6 thriller over Truman last week, was held to 58 yards rushing for the contest.
