Council Rock (2-5, 2-1), which had won only once before yesterday's Suburban One League National Conference Patriot Division game, defeated a Neshaminy team (4-3, 1-3) that was rated ninth in Southeastern Pennsylvania by The Inquirer.

Two weeks ago, Council Rock lost a 3-2 decision to Central Bucks West, the top-ranked team in the Delaware Valley.
