

Langhorne rips Trenton

Scott Obringer ran for 136 yards in the rain last night and scored two touchdowns, leading host Neshaminy Langhorne to a 35-0 nonleague victory over Trenton (0-4).

Obringer's TD runs covered 11 and 5 yards as Langhorne (4-2) scored in every quarter. Bruce Apt went 20 yards for a touchdown with a blocked punt.

Hill 7, Mercersburg 0 — Chuck Collie's five-yard touchdown run capped a 65-yard drive in the third quarter by Hill School in the nonleague game.

Hill's defense held the visitors (2-

3) to 55 rushing yards, and the winners (3-2) picked up 205 yards, including 85 by Collie on 15 carries.

Parents Day activities at Hill also included competition with Mercersburg in three other sports. The Hill defeated Mercersburg in soccer, 4-1, and in cross country, 17-46, but took a narrow loss in water polo, 15-14.

"Mercersburg came from so far away," said Hill athletic director Dave Mercer, "that we would have had to make a postponement decision by 6:30 this morning. The field wasn't really in bad shape."
