LANGHORNE — Joe Sroba scored three touchdowns and Pete Cordelli threw for a pair Friday night as Neshaminy continued unbeaten by hammering Freedom 34-8.

The Patriots stayed in the game for a half, but its defense, which spent most of the night on the field, simply could not do it all.

The Redskins scored on their second play from scrimmage in the second half and never let up to pull away for the win.

Some fine punting by Bob Reinert, who averaged 42 yards for five kicks, kept Neshaminy on its own end of the field in the first half and set up the lone Freedom score in the final period.

He got off a 64-yarder that was fumbled and lost on the Redskin four-yard line and

scored himself from one yard out.

After an exchange of punts following the kickoff, Neshaminy went 58 yards on 10 plays for a touchdown.

A 13-yard pass from Cordelli to Dale Forchetti set up Sroba's one-yard plunge.

After the second-half kickoff, Forchetti returned a punt 15 yards to midfield, took a 12-yard pass for a first down and ran a down, out and up pattern for 39 yards and the score. Rich McIntyre added his second of four placements making the score 14-0.

Forchetti then intercepted a pass on Freedom's first play from scrimmage following the kickoff and ran it back to the Patriot 35. A penalty put the ball at midfield, but five plays later, Cordelli hit Sroba with a 19-yard scoring strike that was set up by a pass interference call.

Neshaminy made the score 28-0 on a 76-yard drive on eight plays in the final quarter. Sroba hit left tackle and veered outside for the final 13 yards.

Forchetti made one of his few blunders when he muffed Reinert's booming kick and the big Patriot fullback bulled over from the one-yard line three plays later.

Freedom tried an unsuccessful outside kick to help set up Neshaminy's final score. The Redskins took the ball at midfield and Bruce Traney scored from seven yards out six plays later.
