

# Neshaminy Seeks 6th Win in Row

Bethlehem Liberty, which defeated Pennsbury, 7-0, two weeks ago, will attempt to stop undefeated Neshaminy tonight in a Big Seven Conference game at Neshaminy.

The Redskins bring a 5-0 record into the game while Liberty is 4-1. Thomas Jefferson High from Brooklyn, N. Y., defeated Liberty, 22-20, three weeks ago.
