

Central Bucks West Tops Souderton in Final Period

Central Bucks West got TD runs of 13 yards by Ray Rodemer and seven yards by Tom Duff in the final five minutes Friday night to edge visiting Souderton, 26-22, in a Bux-Mont League game at Doylestown.

The Bucks' other six-pointers came on Pat Carey passes of 74 yards to Steve Jensen and 28 yards to Jeff Stemple. Souderton scored on a 35-yard pass from Gary Nau to Doug Hespell and runs of three yards by Eric Bergoy and 61 yards by Greg Bray.

Neshaminy maintained its No. 1 ranking in the Delaware Valley by handing host William Allen a 33-7 defeat in a Big Seven Conference game at Allentown. Allen scored first on Mike Squires' 84-yard punt return but the Redskins retaliated with a 38-yard pass from Pete Cordelli to Dale Forchetti. The four other Neshaminy TDs were picked up by Bruce Traney on runs of two, two, four and 12 yards.

In other Bux-Mont action Pennridge nipped Upper Perkiomen, 8-7, on quarterback Paul Auckland's conversion run following a seven-yard TD dash by Dean Frankenfield. The losers' six-pointer came on a 12-yard run by Brian Moyer.

QUAKERTOWN RALLIES

Don Storck's 45-yard sprint set up his second touchdown of the night, a one-yard run with 2:30 left, as host Quaker-

town rallied for a 20-13 win over North Penn. Frank Loew also scored for the winners while Pete Robinson accounted for all the North Penn points.

Jack Deloplaine ran for three touchdowns as host Pottstown overwhelmed Pottsgrove, in a Ches-Mont League game, 53-0.

Lou Zandy tallied twice on two-yard plunges to lead West Chester in a 36-14 romp over host Boyertown. Cliff Donnelly gave the Warriors the lead for good on a 39-yard ramble with a recovered fumble early in the second period.
