

Traney Scores Twice As Neshaminy Rolls

Unbeaten Neshaminy High made Allentown Dieruff its fifth victim by 26-8 Friday night in a Big Seven Conference game at Allentown.

Bruce Traney tallied twice on runs of one and 12 yards, with Pete Cordelli teaming up on a 70-yard scoring pass with Dale Forchetti for a third Neshaminy TD. The fourth came on a one-yard plunge by Pete Schapakus.

In the Bux-Mont League, Central Bucks West and Pennridge moved into a first-place tie with Hatboro-Horsham. Central Bucks West overwhelmed Perkiomen Valley at Doylestown, 56-0, as Tom Duff and Max Guydon each scored twice. The other six-pointers came on a 62-yard sprint by Ray Rodemer, a 40-yard pass from Pat Carey to Steve Jensen, and short runs by Dusty Bryan and Craig Schillo.

Paul Auckland scored on a three-yard sneak and connected with Greg Cook on a 52-yard bomb to lead Pennridge in a 35-14 win over North Penn at Lansdale.

Souderton downed Wissahickon, 23-14, as Eric Bergey and Steve Edwards each scored on short plunges and Paul Lotier rambled 45 yards with a recovered fumble. Placekicker Jeff Forjan added two conversions and booted a 27-yard field goal.
