

All-Suburban Sweep For PAC-10 Backs

Many times, it is necessary to search far and wide to come up with the best running backs in District 1. But this year, all you really had to do was check out the Pioneer Athletic Conference

In Phoenixville's Chris Minor, Pottstown's Brian Campbell and Upper Perkiomen's Henry Sykes, the league was able to claim a clean sweep at that position on the 1988 Daily News All-Suburban football squad

Not that there weren't other wor-thy candidates. The first-team multi-purpose back, Hatboro-Horsham's Chris Horstman, rushed for 1,277 yards on 234 carries and scored 20 touchdowns, including six in one game. He was also just as good at linebacker and on special teams. On the second unit are a pair of juniors, Wissahickon's Andrew Hyde (1,600 yards) and Coatesville's Dwayne Miller (1,528), who undoubtedly will be heard from again next fall. And Ridley's Fran Naselli, who ran for 1,190 yards, scored 28 touchdowns and 170 points, both area bests

Still, the senior trio from the PAC-10 was, at least in my opinion, just a tad more deserving, for a variety of reasons (hey, nobody ever said this wasn't a subjective undertaking).

Minor, a repeat choice from 1987, gained 1,205 yards in 126 attempts (9.6 average), caught 10 more pa for almost 200 yards, and scored 20 touchdowns - despite missing the final 21/2 games with a knee injury. He has been timed in 4.3 seconds over 40 yards, and generated some Division I interest. But because of that late injury, he probably will wind up at the NCAA Division 1-AA level.

Campbell rushed for 1,537 yards on 232 carries, had 16 receptions for 251 yards, and 24 TDs. He is getting re-cruited mainly by Division II pro-grams, but he is likely to go big time as a wrestler.

Sykes, who operated behind an offensive line that was not nearly as strong as those of either Phoenixville or Pottstown, ran for 1,363 yards on 233 carries, had 13 catches for 236

vards, and scored 21 TDs. He rushed for 293 yards in one game. Syracuse reportedly heads the list of schools that wants to sign him.

All three, by the way, played de-fense as well. And keep in mind that the PAC-10 had four other running backs make honorable mention.

But if you want to throw the football, you could do a lot worse than to ride the right arm of Ridley's Bill Bair. After getting off to a rocky start in his first two games, he finished with 83 completions in 159 passes, for 1,505 yards and 18 TDs and just seven interceptions. A solid guard in basketball, Bair also was good enough to make all-Central League as a defensive back

The All-Suburban receivers are Tom Lafferty, Bair's teammate at Ridley, and Phoenixville's Steve Tufillaro. Lafferty, who also placekicked and played defense, had 28 recep-tions for 769 yards and 10 touch-downs. Tufillaro caught 34 passes for 698 yards and 10 TDs.

How about a coach of the year? That award goes to Interboro's Jerry Kennedy. In his second season, he guided the Bucs to a 9-2 record and the Del Val American championship, even though they weren't expected to do too much. Along the way, Interboro won five games by one point each

Others considered were Bristol's George Gatto, Neshaminy's John Chaump, Central Bucks West's Mike Pettine, Coatesville's Mike Domi-nick, Souderton's Drew Darrah, St. Pius X's Bill Rogers and Penn Wood's Mike Guille.

As usual, here are a couple of things to remember:

One, not all honorable mentions are created equal. Two, the selections are based on

performance. In other words, it's not necessarily a list of the best prospects.

 And finally, when it's really close, a senior is generally chosen over a junior, or an all-around talent over somebody who for the most part was one-dimensional. If it's still too tough to call, other factors are figured into the equation, such as the level of the competition, or how much a player

meant to his team.
