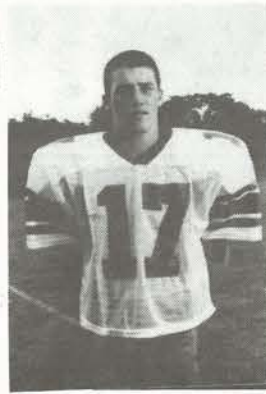
**Tom Irwin - "IRR" - # 65**

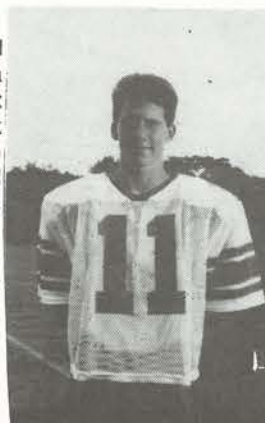
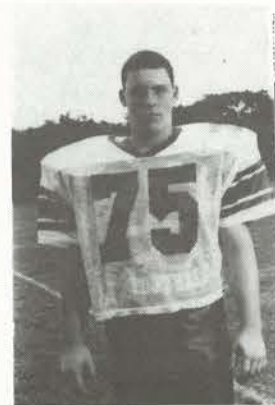
**Mark Griffin - "Money" - # 2**

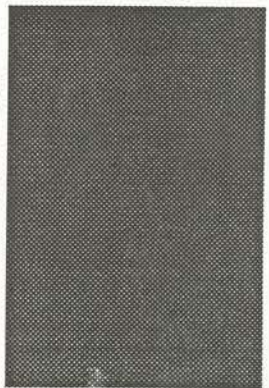
**Keith Krajnikovich - # 57**

**Joe Cole - # 83**

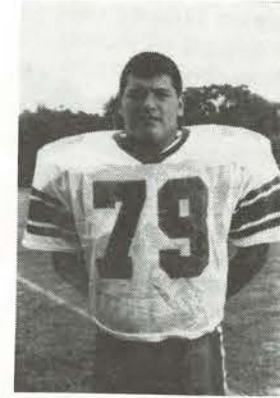
