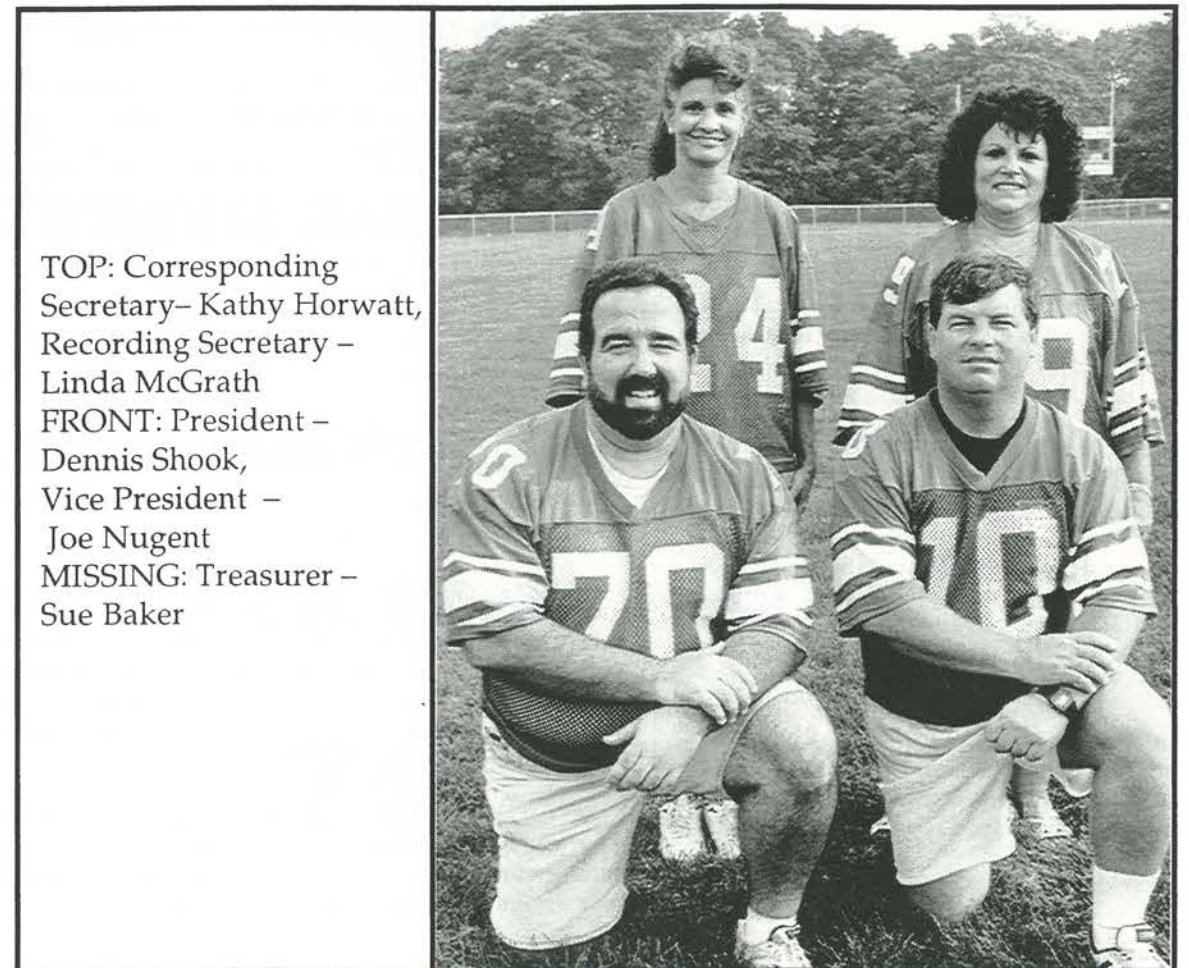

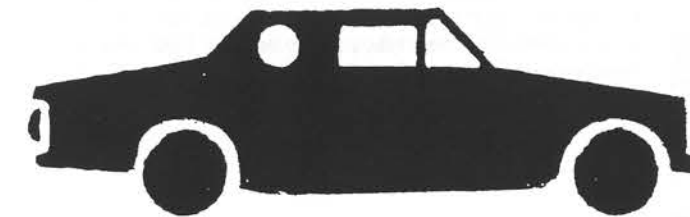

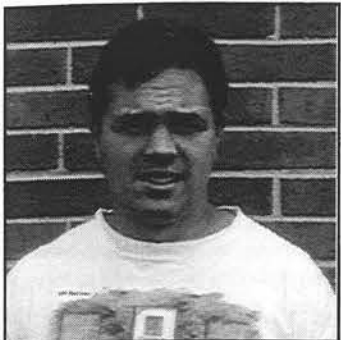

COACHING STAFF



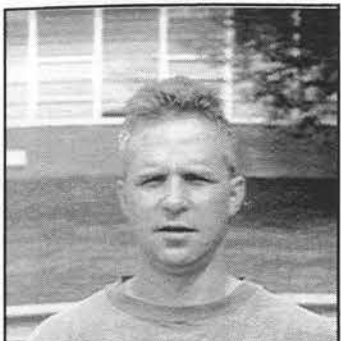
VINCE BEDESEM- DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR/LINEBACKERS

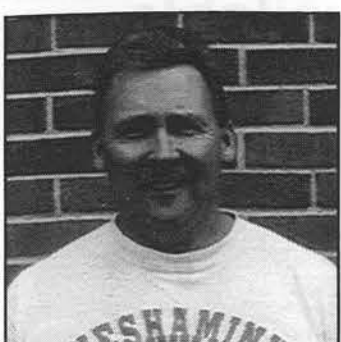
TOM MAGDELINKAS- OFFENSIVE LINE, KICKERS

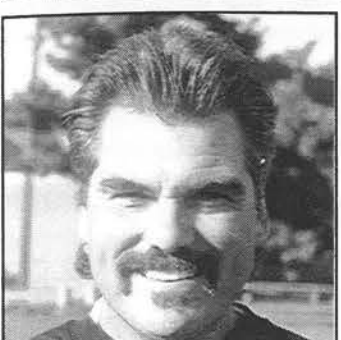
BILL FERRERA- OFFENSIVE BACKFIELD

DON WIATER- SPECIAL TEAMS

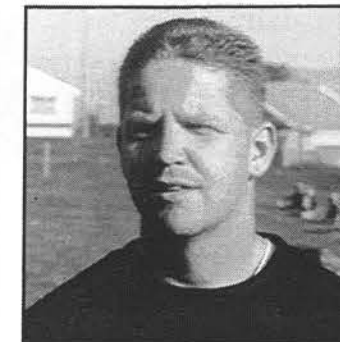

ED HOFMAN- LINEBACKERS

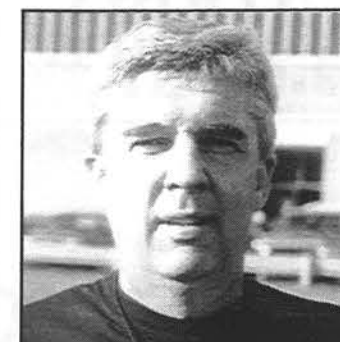

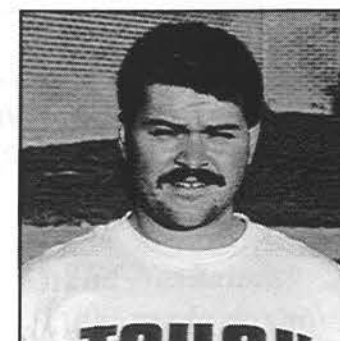
COLIN TRICKEL – DEFENSIVE BACKS

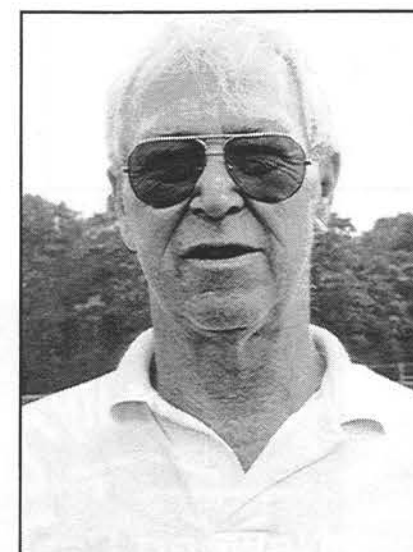
BERNIE GAVLICK – TIGHT ENDS / RECEIVERS

DICK BEDESEM, SR. – HEAD COACH

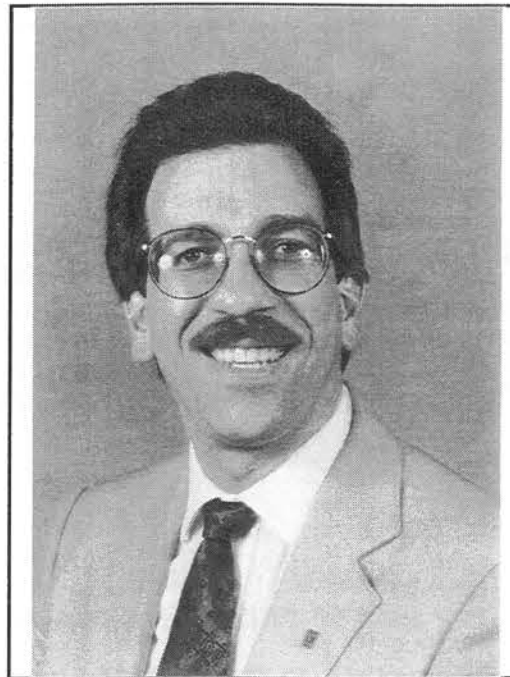
