Best wishes to the NHS Marching Band and Color Guard. You too have worked hard, and the proof of your success is displayed every week at pre-game and/or half-time performances.

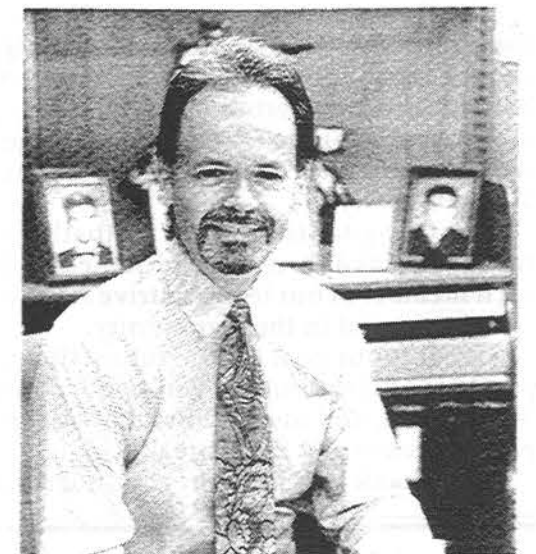

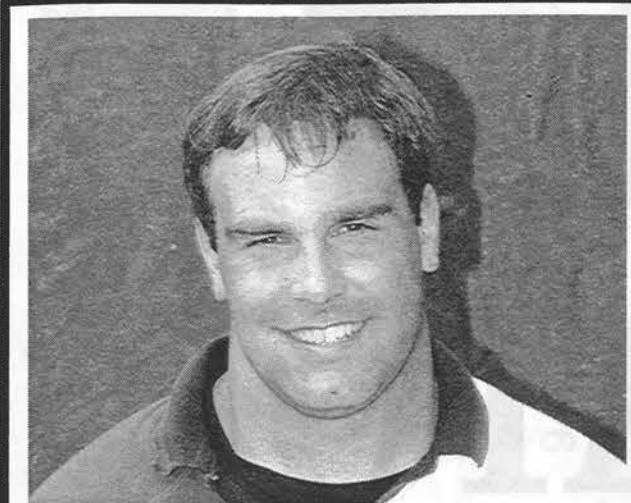
Don Wiater - Defensive Line

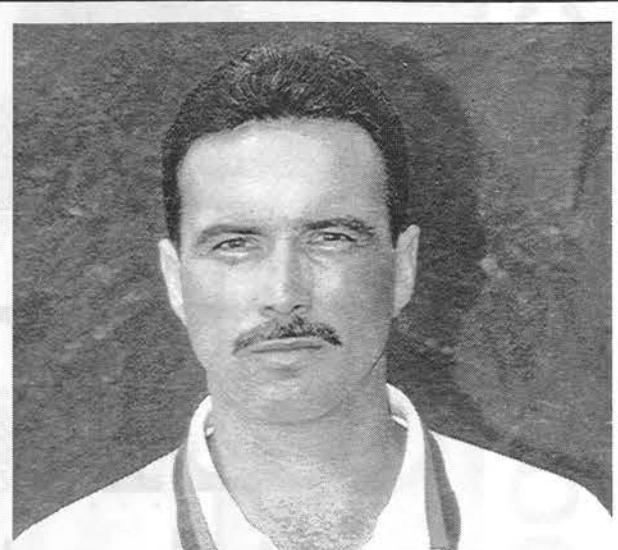
Jim McFarland - Linebackers

Steven Wilmot - Defensive Ends/Offensive Line

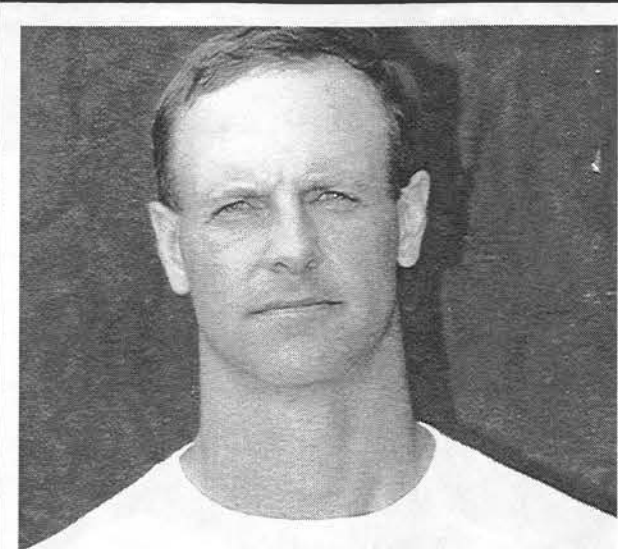

Bruce Edwards - Offensive Line

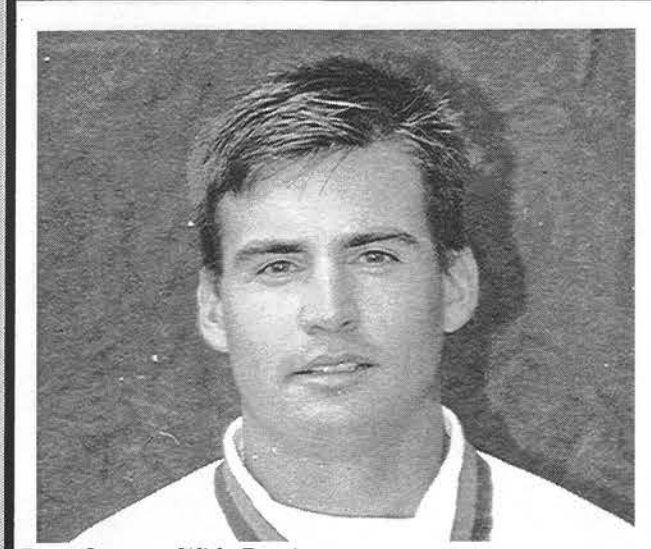

The Redskin Eleven are the best weight lifters according to the Schwartz Formula, a system of equally measuring big and small athletes used in International Olympic competition. A coefficient is given to each athlete according to their body weight. The heavier the athlete, the lower the coefficient. The lighter the athlete the higher the coefficient. The coefficient is multiplied by the total amount of weight lifted in the bench, squat, and power clean. 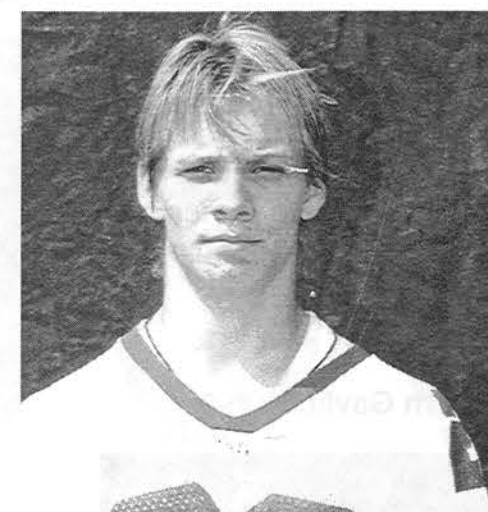
After high school, I plan to go to college to become a physical education teacher. I enjoy writing and playing music. My parents have taught me what it means to be a Christian young man with love and integrity.
