Directions to Away Games

Pennridge High School

Take Route 413 North to Route 202 South. Route 202 South to Route 313 West. Route 313 West to 5th Street in Perkasie (Approximately 25 minutes). Turn left onto 5th Street. School is 1/2 mile on the right.

Central Bucks East High School

Central Bucks East High School football games are held at War Memorial. Take Street Road West to Route 511 North to the Chalfont exit. (There are signs there for the Doylestown Hospital & Route 202 South.) Take a left off the ramp on to State Street. The first road on the right after the light at the hospital will be Memorial Drive. Turn right on Memorial Drive and the field will be on the left.

Abington High School

Abington High School games are played at Memorial Field. Take PA Turnpike to Willow Grove exit #27. Head south on Route 611. Pass Abington Memorial Hospital and the next light is Susquehanna Road. Make left and the field is on the next block.

Pennsbury High School

Take Route 1 north to Oxford Valley exit (Sesame Place). Turn right onto Oxford Valley Road. Cross Route 1 and bear left, remaining on Oxford Valley road (which becomes Levittown Parkway at Trenton Road). Take Levittown Parkway to Hood Blvd., turn left. School is on the left.
