## 10-YARD LINE OVERTIME PROCEDURE

The following procedure will be in effect whenever a PIAA Football Championship game ends regulation play with the score tied:

When the score is tied at the end of the fourth period, the referee will instruct both teams to return to their respective team boxes. There will be a three-minute intermission during which both teams may confer with their coaches.

At the coin toss in the center of the field the visiting team's captain shall be given the privilege of calling the coin while it is in the air. The winner of the toss shall be given his choice of defense or offense first, or of designating the end of the field at which the ball will be put in play for this set of downs. The loser will have his choice of the other options.

Each team shall be permitted one additional time-out during each overtime period (a series for A and a series for B) plus any unused second-half regulation game time-outs. The team scoring the greater number of points in the overtime shall be declared the winner. The final score shall be determined by totaling all points scored by each team during both regulation time and overtime periods.

To start the overtime, the offensive team shall put the ball in play, first and goal, on the defensive team's 10-yard line anywhere between the inbounds lines. The first offensive team shall have a series of four downs. That series shall be terminated by any score by the offensive team or if the defensive team has possession of the ball.

If the team on the offense scores a touchdown, it is entitled to the opportunity for a try unless the points would not affect the outcome of the game or playoff qualifying.

A field-goal attempt is permitted during any down.

If the defensive team gains possession, the ball becomes dead immediately and the offensive team's series of downs is ended.

After the first team on offense has completed its series of downs, the first team on defense will become the offensive team with the ball in its possession at the same 10-yard line anywhere between the inbounds lines. The same end of the field will be used for possessions by both teams during the two sets of downs to ensure equal game conditions and conserve time.

If the score remains tied after each team has been given one series of downs in an overtime period, then the procedure shall be repeated with other overtime periods until a game winner is determined. In this case, there shall be an intermission of two minutes. At the subsequent meeting of team captains, the loser of the overtime coin toss will be given first choice of the options. If additional overtime periods are required, then first options will be alternated with no coin toss.

If a safety is scored by the offensive team, the succeeding spot will be the 10-yard line in possession of the team that was on defense, provided the defensive team has not had its series of downs (the temporary overtime score is: Team A-2; Team B-0).

When the defensive team gains possession of the ball, the down and series immediately end for the offensive team.

The offensive team shall be awarded a new series of downs when any one of the following occurs:


- a. Penalty for defensive pass interference is accepted.
- b. Offensive team recovers a scrimmage kick (field-goal attempt) between the goal lines after it has been touched first by the defensive team beyond the neutral zone.
- c. Defensive team is guilty of roughing the kicker, place-kick holder, snapper or passer.


The line-to-gain is always the goal line.

If the defensive team scores a safety or touchdown, the game is ended.

No try will be attempted if the winner of the game has been determined.


Southern Columbia High School Team Record: 14-0 (District IV A Champion)
The Southern Columbia football team has won a state record 11 straight District titles and tied another for their 7th appearance in the PIAA Championship game.
The Tigers have had 12 wins in every season since 1990 except one (11 wins in 200).
This undefeated season has been very special, with impressive wins over larger rival schools and state powers (Mt. Carmel 22-0, Selinsgrove 35-7, Danville 41-7 and Pius X in the Eastern Final 35-8).

The defensive squad on this year's team has been dominant, posting some of the finest number in program history. The Tigers have recorded 5 shutouts while allowing only one score 6 times for an average of 6.7 points per game. The defense has allowed only 120 total yards per game, with an impressive 1.8 yards yielded per rushing attempt. The offense has also been strong, averaging over 40 points per game while accumulating over 4,000 yards rushing and 5, 400 yards in total

This year's game is a rematch from last season and if the Tigers can reverse the result it would equal the program's best year (1994) with a perfect 15-0 record and the PIAA Championship.

The Pen Argyl football team posted 10-0 regular season records during the 199 and 2000 campaigns. Although the team suffered heavy losses through graduation, the 2001 Green Knights not only own a 12-0 record entering the second round of the PIAA Football Championships, but captured the third District XI Championship in the school's history and first in the "AA" classification.

Picked to finish in the middle of the pack in the Colonial League, the squad responded with its third straight undefeated season, including a hard fought 7-3 victory over Northern Lehigh and a dramatic 14-10 come-from-behind win over Northwestern Lehigh. The District XI playoffs had a distinctively Colonial League flavor, with the Knights earning a second victory over Norther Lehigh (14-6) in the first round and Northwestern Lehigh (14-0) in the finals.

The 2001 team can best be described as a well-balanced attack on offense and a stingy defense. Although the versatility of quarterback Jake deBoer, the inside running of Ed McGinley, and the timely pass catching of McGinley, tight end Jared Meckler, and running backs Chad DiFelice and Billy Toth have provided much of the offensive spark, the unheralded play of the linemen on both sides of the ball has played a major role in the team's success. The defense, anchored by lineman Jeremy Savitz, linebackers McGinley and DiFelice, and Toth, a defensive back, has allowed more than one touchdown only once during the 2001 campaign. Coach Roy Cortez, who led the team to a District XI "A" title in 1984, is in the fifth year of his current tenure. The 2001 season has been a record-shattering one for the Washington Little Prexies' football team. Washington enters the PIAA Class AA championship game with a school-record 14 wins and 593 points. The Little Prexies have won 46 of their past 52 games.

In 2001, the Little Prexies have captured the Interstate Conference championship, the school's 6th WPIAL title and its 2nd PIAA Western crown. Washington has scored more than 40 points in 10 games this season, another school record, and scored more than 50 points three times. Washington's pivotal regular-season win came against rival Waynesburg, 47-0, in early October. The Little Prexies' undefeated and untied regular season was their ninth. In his 22nd season, Coach Guy Montecalvo owns a 185-67-2 record, a .732 winning percentage, and a 24-15 mark in post-season play. In its 101-year football history, Washington has won 569

Ward and Travis Thomas, who have rushed for 1,045 and 1,007 yards, respectively. Receiver Brian Skaggs has caught 35 passes for 579 yards while Vontey Johnson has rushed for 830 yards and scored 22 TDs. Senior two-way tackle Dan Mozes leads the team in tackles with 85, while Skaggs leads in interceptions with seven and Johnson in sacks with 11.
