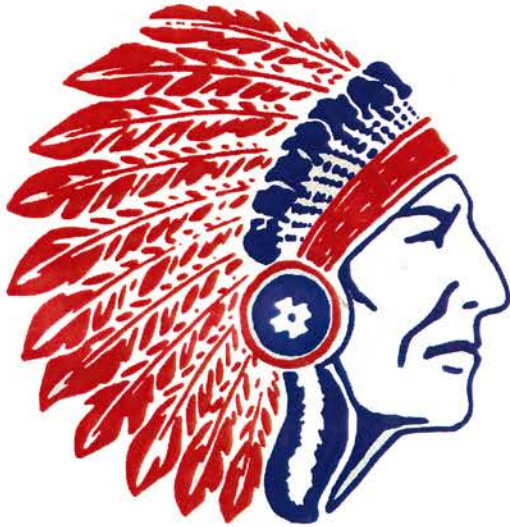

Head Football Coach

Coach Mark Schmidt is entering his eighth season as Redskin Head Coach. Prior, he served six seasons as Offensive Line Coach and Recruiting Coordinator at Lock Haven University. There, he was instrumental in implementing the Run & Shoot offense, which was nationally ranked during his last three seasons. As Recruiting Coordinator, Schmidt was no stranger to the Suburban One Conference, actively recruiting high school players throughout Southeastern Pennsylvania, Southern New Jersey and Delaware.

Prior to Lock Haven, Schmidt coached under Jerry Berndt at Temple University and the University of Pennsylvania. At Penn the team earned Ivy League Championship honors both seasons he was there. He also was a Tight End Coach under Jerry Claiborne at the University of Kentucky.

Schmidt's first coaching experiences actually came in the Suburban One Conference, when in 1982 and 1983, he coached under the direction of close friend and Norristown Area High School head coach Roger Grove. During those years, Norristown won back-to-back Suburban One Conference Championships.

A Graduate of Lower Moreland High School, Schmidt earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physical Education from Ursinus College, where he was an All-Conference linebacker. Schmidt currently resides in Plymouth Meeting, PA, with his wife Maribeth and their daughter Erica, born February 26, 1997.

## Directions to Away Games

### Council Rock – North

Take U.S. Rte. 1 North to Rte. 413 North. Follow 413 North through Langhorne, pass St. Mary Hospital and the George School. Turn left at the traffic light pass George School. Go through 2 lights and turn right onto Swamp Road (right turn past 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light). School is on the left.

### Abington High School

Take PA turnpike to Willow Grove exit #27. Head south on Rte. 611. Go Past Abington Memorial Hospital and the next light is Susquehanna Rd. Make left and the field is on the left (next block).

### Truman High School

Take U.S. Rte 1 north to Rte. 213 exit. Make a left on Rte 213 and go to Woodbourne Rd. Make a right on Woodbourne Rd. and follow past Five Points intersection. Go right onto Mill Creek Rd. Follow to Green Lane. Make a right at Green Lane and a left into parking lot.

### Central Bucks East High School

CB East football games are held at War Memorial. Take Street Rd West to Rte 611 North to the Chalfont exit (Doylestown Hospital & Rte 202 South). Make a left off the ramp onto State St. The 1<sup>st</sup> road on the right after the light at the hospital will be Memorial Drive and the field will be on the left.

### North Penn High School

Take the PA turnpike to Northeast Extension to Exit 31 (Lansdale). Make a left at light onto Sumneytown Pike. Follow Sumneytown Pike approximately 3 miles. Stadium will be on the left.
